This is a ruined building made of mud bricks and river cobbles. It is said by Mr Du Plessis to have been a store related to the farm complex in this area. Towards the river is a mound with four iron poles in it. It is uncertain what this feature is. It seems unlikely to be a grave since no bones are present in the spoils of an aardvark burrow dug into the mound.
