This structure is a large building, probably a barn, with the remains of two sash windows. There is a smaller room on the northern end of the building which had a single window. The entire roof and the door of the room have been removed. Some old farm machinery is standing inside and just in front of the building. The foundations of another building are located a short way upslope and are not recorded separately. There is also a cement feature to the west of the barn that was probably for dipping livestock.
