Scatters of Middle Stone Age (MSA) stone artefacts were mainly documented within the farm roads. The stone artefacts comprise mostly of flakes, blades and cores made on hornfels, fine-grained quartzite, silcrete, chalcedony, shale, and a few quartz chunks were also present. At Site 28 stone artefacts were observed in the stratigraphy of the road cutting at the bottom of a hill. The stone artefacts may have washed down the hill over time. Abandoned farm houses and buildings occur.
