**SiteComments:**

A single rectangular outline of packed rocks, approximately 2.4m long and 1.0m wide and oriented south-north constitute the structure. At approximately 1.4m from the southern end the structure is divided by a row of packed rocks. The southern border of this structure is constructed of carefully laid rocks, with a single large rock vertically in the middle. This structure might be the surface dressing of a grave, or possibly two graves laying end-to-end. The orientation of the structure, however, argues against this and it might, therefore be the foundations of a small shed or other structure of undetermined purpose
