The dilapidated remains of a mud brick settlement were identified at this location . The settlement was identified within a clearing in the natural bush which measured approximately 40m in diameter. The dilapidated remains of this mud brick settlement covered an area of approximately 20m x 20m and consisted of several structures which formed part of the larger settlement. Most of the structures were in a very dilapidated state and were very difficult to identify. The number, size and shape of the structures of this settlement were not clearly identifiable. Rocks were used in the foundations to support the mud brick walls of the structures. Several modern metal artefacts, such as wire, corrugated iron and a cast iron pot were found scattered around the site.
