This site comprises the foundations of a farmhouse complex. The main structure was a multi-room stone and brick house, probably with a corrugated iron roof. The house has however completely collapsed and all the door and window frames and other wooden or steel fittings have been removed. An extensive midden was also recorded to the east of the main house remains. Pieces of glass, ceramics, metal, bone and even complete bottles were noted. The farmhouse probably dates to the mid-1800s.
