Shell midden, but the exact size is not known. A part of the accumulation may be covered by dune sand and vegetation. . Shell midden is a Local Grade IIIB/IVA site and of medium significance. It should be mitigated before destruction. o The site falls outside the footprint and is not directly under threat from the proposed development, but is directly under threat from the public (vehicles). 22 This shell midden was exposed in the side of the vehicle track between the foot of the calcareous ridge and the rocky coast. A 5-10 cm lens was exposed over a distance of 11 metres. The shell fish content is similar to those middens discussed nearby, for example RCW/sm4. Apart from a few quartzite stone flakes, no other cultural material was found.
