Gable with fretwork bargeboardings, 3 finials and circular louvred set in gable vent. Corners rusticate plaster. Verandah with bullnose roof on heavily rusticated pillars. Glazed screen to right end. Dipped walls with red plaster coping and razor blade morif all slightly arched. Door, flushed panel, with slightly arched fanlight behind screen 2 X2 sashes with louvred shutters. Light red/brown roofs and woodwork. To the left garage extension with straight parapet attached to no. 12. Double door with masterboard garden gate shutting to left.
