Smooth raised plaster surrounds to openings, edging and below string course with step down over central bay. Verandah with straight roof on precast columns and dipped walls with printed tile columns coping and diamond motif set in wall. End walls higher with double concave flat topped coping. Modern half glazed door with single pane fanlight. 2 x 2 sashes with louvred shutters. Garage extension to the left with straight parapet and double cast iron door with trellis carport to front.
