Archive Import History: Visual Description: Neo-Gothic hall church with high-pitched roof, rounded point windows and end gables. High pitched slate roof with cast iron ridge crest and hut-shaped vents. Gable and side wall have heavy plaster mouldings and rustication. Pilasters and half buttresses also on porch. Rounded, pointed Neo-Gothic windows with eyebrow mouldings. Caledon Street facade has large stained glass window with rosette. Low walls with wrought iron fencing along streets.
