Archive Import History: Visual Description: L-plan house with pitched gabled corrugated iron roof. Abuts neighbours. Shouldered end gables (with pinnacles) and covered triangular front gables, 2 in Bourke Street. One in van Ryneveld Square. Arched loft doors in end gables and arched louvred ventilators in front gables. Plastered walls. Stone stoep in both streets. Modern replica 4 panel front door with 2 pane fanlight. (Bourke Street). Facade to Van Ryneveld Square has modern glazed door. 12 x 12 sashes with louvred shutters. Small steel window (bath) in van Ryneveld Square. High chimneys with VRS gable and on ridge behind front gable on Van Ryneveld Square. Extension to Van Ryneveld Square incorporating wide arched opening with slatted double gate. Situated under same parapet as extension of no.17 Van Ryneveld Square. Colours: White walls. Dark green woodwork.
