Archive Import History: Visual Description: 3 Bay double-storey corner house with doubl-storey balcony. Pitched hipped slate roof with a chimney att each end with chimney pots. Walls with rustication and raised smooth and sked plaster surrounds to openings and edges. New double-storey balcony (see no. 10), with straight hipped roof on steel tubes with wrought iron railings. Flared steps. Front facade first floor geometric french door, two pane fanlight. 3 x 3 panel double door with fanlight. 2 x 2 sashes in ground floor, 12 x 12 sashes in upper floor.
