Wall has rusticated and recessed porch. Stone stoep with old plaster. Dipped walls with strap moulded coping with central part protruding. 3 x 3 panel double door lower panel flush with central part protruding. 3 x 3 panel double door lower panel flush with 4 pane fanlight, divided horizontally and vertically. From porch also two 4 panel doors to stoepkamers. 12 x 12 sashes with louvred shutters. Double wrought iron gate to left, with car port behind. Attached double garage underflat-roof and flat parapet. Straight sloping parapet to sides. Strap moulded parapet. Double timber doors. Colours: Dark green woodwork.
