Archive Import History: Visual Description: Long 7 bay Karoo-type building set back in garden. It has two wings which are bay-shaped with splayed corners. The high parapets are heavily moulded. Walls are rusticated. Verandah along the whole front with concave roof, ornamental fretwork and wooden posts. Flag rail. Entrance is glazed and modern, but also half-glazed double doors with 2 pane fanlights. The splayed wings have Edwardian type casement windows. Also small square casement windows between doors. High Edwardian(/) chimneys. Fine cast iron fence and gates along street. Palms and falkland pines in front.
