Archive Import History: Visual Description: ELONGATED PLAN BELOW RIDGED AND PARAPET GABLED ROOF WITH ORNATE ENTRANCE GABLE ON SIDE OF THE BUILDING. TIMBER DOUBLE DOORS FROM THE ENTRANCE AND IS DECORATED WITH PLASTER MOULDING SURROUNDS. FENESTRATION MAKES USE OF LARGE 12 PANE ARCHED WINDOWS WITH ORNATE VENTILATORS BETWEEN THE WINDOWS. THE WHOLE FACADE IS TREATED WITH HORIZONTAL PLASTER RENDERING. BUILDING STANDS ON A STONE PLINTH AND ONE OF THE GABLE ENDS ABUTTS AGAINST THE BUILDING NEXT TO IT. THERE ARE 3 METAL VENTILATORS ON THE ROOF.
