Archive Import History: The corner-stone of this impressive complex was laid on 27 February 1934 by Prince George, Duke of Kent It was designed by Gordon Leith and erected by W. F. and P. du Plessis. The City Hall complex was officially opened on 4 December 1936 by the Earl of Clarendon, the then Governor-General of the Union of South Africa.
