Archive Import History: In 1929 H Live commissioned architect Ritchie Mckinley to design a building named Quadrant House. Local tradition has it that the building was designed as naval training school. Visual Description: Double-storied house of quadrant form; broken up vertically by paired Tuscan Doric columns; central bay, ceramic shell motif and projection pavillion roofs; windows and a balcony tie the facade together. Colours: Site Features:The property with the so-called Quadrant house thereon described as, subdivision 5 of Lot 35 of Bay Foreshore Lands (now known as Sub-division 5 of Lot 35, Block 3F OF THE TOWNLANDS OF DURBAN NO.1737).
