Archive Import;Significance: Battlesiteof significant victoryfor the Boers against British forces led by Sir George Pomeroy Colley (killed in action) on 26th February 1881. History: Majuba Battlefield;Conservation Area, proclaimed to provide protection for the wider battlefield area. Sir George Pomeroy Colley led a mixed force of British troops to the top of Majuba Hill, overlooking the Boer encampments. The battle which ensued on 26th February 1881 was a resounding victory for the Boers.
