Archive Import History: Visual Description: Three-bay saddle-roofed Victorian-type building. Verandah has a straight roof on plastered brick pillars and arches. 2x2-panelled double door (top panels arched), with arched four-paned fanlight. Arched side-hung windows with small panes. There is a round vent above verandah roof. Corner pilasters, and a fine cornice above verandah roof. Full-width steps from verandah and semi-circular low wall in front of steps. There is a short wing extension on the left side with a door. A very striking building of local architectural and cultural value and should be investigated for proclamation.
