Archive Import History: The property transfer for 'Bordeaux' took place in 1835 when the Dutch Reformed Church Visual Description: Single storey with hipped roof and decorative bargeboard dormer over entrance. Remains of stepped side parapet on right. Symmetrical five bay facade. Ruled joints, edge pilasters and smooth opening surrounds. Low stoep with precast balustrade. Verandah (with dormer matching main one) on precast Ionic columns. 6x6 double sliding sash windows. Excellent 6-apert double door under single pane fanlight. Later glazed door to left. Excellent condition. Retains original appearance almost entirely.
