Symmetrical semi-detached houses on stone plinth. Two-bay facades with projecting wings. Right hand projecting wing forms stoepkamer. Elaborately detailed wooden verandah with elaborate turned post drops and profiled hand rail and St. Andrews Cross ..... balustrade. High stone stoep with fretwork railings. Ogee verandah on plastered dividing wall and timber supports. Symmetrically placed curved entrance stair on either side of dividing wall. 2x2 double sliding sash windows with louvered shutters. Original 6-panelled doors with single pane fanlight. Excellent condition. Original appearance.
