Archive Import History: Visual Description: Cape Georgian double storey with flat roof, projecting cornice and decorative parapet. Stepped on sides with string coarse. Symmetrical three bay facade. Low plastered stoep (verandah on plastered piers removed after 1980). Lower windows steel, upper 12x12 double sliding sash. Later 6-panel door and Gothic Revival fanlight. Fair condition. Largely original. Garage and wall attached to right hand side. Flat roofed with simple cornice and stepped parapet. Street fronting boundary wall with plaster coping. Timber door but not original (note: original strap hinges). Good condition. Largely original and important for street continuity. Colours: Site Features: Condition: GoodWindows on ground floor have been manufactured but still need to be put in.
