SiteComments:

Large artefact scatter in a 'bay' at the foot of the cliff below the mine. Very disturbed but could still be rescued as the original context (i.e. surface scatter) has not been changed – spatial data will have been lost though. LSA flaked stone artefacts of quartz, silcrete, quartzite and CCS. Two MSA flakes were also included but these would likely have been background scatter.
