**SiteComments:**

A number of Late Iron Age stone walled sites and features were identified during the survey in the area. The sites are located on hills and outcrops and in the area, and as a result will not be directly impacted on by the proposed development. The development will focus on the flat open sections in the area and will steer clear from the hills. The sites probably form part of a large LIA settlement complex, representing individual settlement units or homesteads with features such as cattle kraals (livestock enclosures), hut bays and other related features. It possibly date to the same time period as the Hurutshe settlement complexes at Kaditshwene and other sites close to Zeerust, and around the late 18th to early 19th century.
