This is a large site consisting of a wide variety of stone walling. The site is found at the foot of and to the north and east of one of the stone hills within the mine boundary. At least 8 different circular shaped walls with a diameter of between 8 and 20 m were counted. The height of the walls differ between 0,40 and 1,20 m. The very dense grass however made it impossible to do an accurate count. After completion of the field work the area was checked on Google and it seems that a few more stone walls than those identified in the field, are present.
