a) Church : Small neo-Gothic church with sanctuary narrower and lower than nave; but 1 resses and arched windows with leaded panes and coloured glass; rough plaster with smooth, partly rusticated surrounds. Gables capped with various plaster crosses; roof with turret ventilators. Small entrance porch on north with cast iron finials, arched timber door. b) Hall : Pointed gables; rough plaster with rusticated quoins. Small gabled entrance porch with double panelled door. High, horizontal timber windows.
