SLD6 appears to be an extensive scatter of shell and pottery that is located on both the north and south sides of the road. The surface shell remains consist of well-preserved oyster fragments. This is significant as no P. perna were observed, this making the site different to previously recorded sites along the road. Sherds from three different vessels were recorded on either side of the road. The site has an archaeological deposit approximately 15 cm – 20 cm below the current surface. The site dates to the Late Iron Age or Historical Period.
