SiteComments:

The archaeological remains included marine shell (P. perna and oyster) and pottery fragments found scattered along the crest of the dune. A concentration of shell indicates that an archaeological deposit is present. The site is currently under dense vegetation making it difficult to locate specific areas of the site. However, this type of dune topography, and site settlement pattern, is similar to that which I have observed in the dunes of Richards Bay. These areas consist of several homesteads (or a village) located on the flatter crest of a dune.
