This is the location of a two parallel stone walls which form a track. It is terraced on a steep hillslope on the northern bank of a small spruit or rivulet. The walling is approx. 40cm wide and 30cm high. It forms an entryway which is orientated roughly north-south and leads to a structure hidden in very dense scrub. There is a second linear wall of single stones packed lower down and parallel to the stream. This was probably a small Swazi kraal.
