Sandy useable floor space on RHS (facing) but no great evidence for this being so. LHS is boulder / rock strewn and this is where painting is found on a roof panel.

**Details of Rock Art:**

On LHS of shelter where roof is lower, on a vertical face on the roof rock. Elsewhere there are panels that give pause for thought whether they once were painted but nothing definitive.

Painting appears to be a patches of pigment - scruffy "palette"
