To assist with planning applications submissions, please note the following:

- Section 38(1) applications will close from 1 December 2021 and reopen on 3 January 2022;
- The 30 days commenting period for Section 38(8) applications submitted to SAHRA from 16 November 2021 will end in 2022. Please do not expect comments on these applications before 15 December 2021. This is in line with section 3 of the NEMA EIA regulations with regards to Public Commenting Periods closing for the Festive Season i.e. no commenting period may include the days between 15 December and 5 January;
- Section 9 alienation applications submitted to the HOU unit will close on the 1 December 2021 and reopen on 3 January 2022;
- Permit applications related to sections 27, 32, 34, 35, and 36 will close on 1 December 2021 and reopen on 3 January 2022. Any permit applications submitted to SAHRA from 2 December 2021 will be processed from 4 January 2022;
- Urgent queries may be directed to case officers on the contact details provided above;
- Please note that SAHRA offices will be closed to members of the public between 22 – 24 December 2021. SAHRA staff will be working remotely during this period and may be contacted via email;
- The SAHRA offices (Cape Town and Pretoria) will be closed from 10am on Friday, 24 December 2021 and will reopen on Monday, 4 January 2022. Please note that staff may take leave before and after those days.
