
TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT: No. 80/10/02/009/62

4. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr C Sidor without the consent of SAHRA.
5. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 April 2011 at the expense of Dr C Sidor.
6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 April 2011.
7. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
10. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.
