



2 a. Steamboat Graphite Mine

- Open Cast Mining of the resource Graphite
- Infrastructure will include:
 - Open pit (11ha);

Mine Lay-out





Beneficiation Plant Layout




Product Transport Route



According to regulated timelines the EIA will be submitted in July and will then go out for comments for 30 days. The final reports will then be submitted to DMRE, and it will take them four months to decide whether the mining rights can be approved, but that does not mean that the mine can start immediatel. We will also wait for the water use license to be approved. It is still a long way to go, but hopefully we will get approval towards the year end or early next year.

4. Upcominmg Activities

The roads are so overgrown, we will have to get a bulldozer to open it. Clearing of bushes will take almost three days.

26 April meeting need to be arrange with the livestock and traditional healers.

One community member will be required to assist moving the contactor while busy drilling, he must come with his food and water because shops will be far away for them



Any other heritage resources as defined in section 3 of the NHRA that may be impacted, such as built structures over 60 years old, sites of cultural significance associated with oral histories, burial grounds and graves, graves of victims of conflict, and cultural landscapes or viewscapes must also be assessed.
