Pulida Energy (RF) (Proprietary) Limited (Pulida) plans to submit a tender for the retrofitting of a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) to the existing Pulida Solar photovoltaic facility located in Letsemeng Local Municipality in the Free State province. Part of the submission requirements is an approved Environmental Authorisation (EA).

The general purpose and utilisation of a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) is to save and store excess electrical output as it is generated, allowing for a timed release of electricity to the grid when the capacity is required. BESS systems therefore provide flexibility in the efficient operation of the electricity grid through decoupling of the energy supply and demand.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) will be housed inside containers or similar structures with a total footprint of up to 4ha in extent. Both Lithium-ion and Redox-flow technology are being considered for the project, depending on which is most feasible at the time of implementation. Possible associated infrastructure includes:

- A Substation with a maximum height of HV busbar up to 10 m max and an HV Building up to 4 m max.
- Access road to the BESS (6m wide road surface with side ditch drainage on each side of the road) branching off existing roads, and internal roads (up to 8m wide) within the footprint of the BESS, as needed.
- MV Cabling (underground or overhead) between the BESS and the HV/MV BESS substation.



- HV Cabling (underground or overhead) between the HV/MV BESS substation and the HV substation
- Fencing around the BESS and the substation for increased security measures.
- Temporary laydown area within the 4ha footprint of the BESS.
- Possible firebreak around the BESS facility which is to be located within the 4ha BESS footprint.




Figure 1: Overview of project location






Figure 1: Overview of project location



Health train visits NC

The Phelophepa Healthcare Train has brought some relief to communities who do not have access to medical care. The train arrived in Kimberley early in June and later departed for Upington and De Aar.

The roaming medical facility offers various types of health care, such as dentistry, optometry, pharmacy and psychology.

The 450 m long train, housing a corporate social investment (CSI) project of Transnet with assistance from the Department of Health, travels year-round across the

country - spending eight weeks in each

province. The project was started in 1994. The mobile hospital was flooded by community members in urgent need of medical care while it was parked at the Kimberley station. Some of its medical units received visits from, on average, between

Patients, who were issued with ticket numbers, arrived from surrounding areas in the early hours of the morning - while some slept at the station the night before to ensure their place in the queue.

Services at all medical units were facilitated by students doing their practical work, under the supervision of the resident

1. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

Two rounds of public participation were undertaken as part of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process.

The first round was undertaken from Thursday, 23rd June 2022 to Monday, 25th July 2022 whereby Interested & Affected Parties (I&AP's) were provided with the opportunity to register and provide comment on the draft BAR.

A second round of public participation was undertaken from 26th July 2022 to 26th August 2022 whereby I&AP's were provided with additional time to register and provide comment

All comments received were review and incorporated in the Basic Assessment Report (BAR) if applicable.

The Public Participation Process (PPP) to date is described in detail below.

1.1 Public Participation Process

The PPP for this Basic Assessment process included the following steps:

- On 23rd June 2022, an advertisement was placed in the local newspaper (*NoordkaapBulletin*) informing the Public of the proposed application and providing the opportunity to register and provide comment as an Interested & Affected Party.
 - No request to register or comments were received.
