### 2 WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Welcome and Introductions was done by Mr Joe Mathebula, the Chairperson of MbeuYashu. He presented the following key points:

- In April 2012, CoAL completed the acquisition of exploration properties in the Soutpansberg Coalfield from Rio Tinto Minerals Development which are held in Chapudi Coal (Pty) Ltd and Kwezi Mining Exploration (Pty) Ltd
- A Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment deal was concluded with Rothe Investments (Pty) Ltd, to form a company called MbeuYashu, meaning "*our seed*". Rothe Investments holds 26% of MbeuYashu, with CoAL owning 74%
- MbeuYashu submitted mining right applications for the Generaal Project in May 2013, and received the acceptance letter from Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) in August 2013
- The consolidation of the coking coal resource in the Soutpansberg offers MbeuYashu the unique opportunity to :

- Enable meaningful socio-economic transformation in the area through the adoption of key areas like education and infrastructural development
- Optimise efficiency of resources and infrastructure
- Create opportunities for partnership to facilitate the objectives of the National Development Plan and the Provincial Growth and Development Strategy

### 3 PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

### 4 HISTORY AND OVERVIEW

Mr Cobus Bronn, Chief Operating Officer of CoAL, and Ms Florence Duval, Corporate Affairs Manager of CoAL jointly presented the CoAL overview and Repositioning Strategy:

#### CoAL : Background


- CoAL is a South African company, with a South African management team. Restructured team in place since 1 June 2013 in line with the company's repositioning strategy



#### Repositioned Mining Development Company

- The company has been in a process of transition over the past few months, moving from an exploration, development and operational company to a project development company
- The vision of the company is to create sustainable value for all its stakeholders, while responsibly producing 7 million tonnes of CoAL per annum
- The company has a pipeline of high quality coking coal projects: Vele, Makhado and Greater Soutpansberg, and is in the process of identification of strategic investors to fund the expansion strategy of Vele, and the Makhado project

- Initial Strategy – two phased project – review of product quality completed
- Board approval for the expansion strategy of the Vele Colliery, Phase 2 construction will commence March 2014
- Full regulatory approval – New Order Mining Right, Water Use Licence, Environmental Authorisations and other Licences
- Structures – Environmental Management Committee, UNESCO, Steercomm (DEA/ SANParks)

### Makhado Project



- The Makhado Project is located in the Soutpansberg Coalfield, 36km north of Makhado town on the N1
- Products : Hard coking coal and thermal coal
- A fund raising strategy is being implemented –R4.5 billion is required
- First mining company in the country to have implemented a parallel regulatory process for NOMR, NEMA and DWA:
  - Establishment of an Integrated Government Forum (IGF) which brought together all regulatory and commenting authorities
  - Election of the Makhado Colliery Community Consultative Forum – duly constituted and representative structure. Democratic process run by an independent organisation, Africore
- Agreement signed between CoAL and members of the Nzhelele Irrigation Farmers to protect jobs and improve assurance of supply
- Benchmarked Public Participation Process :
  - Extended for a 2 year period to ensure that extensive consultation took place
  - Formation of working and focus groups

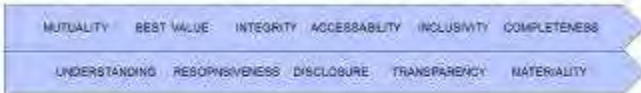

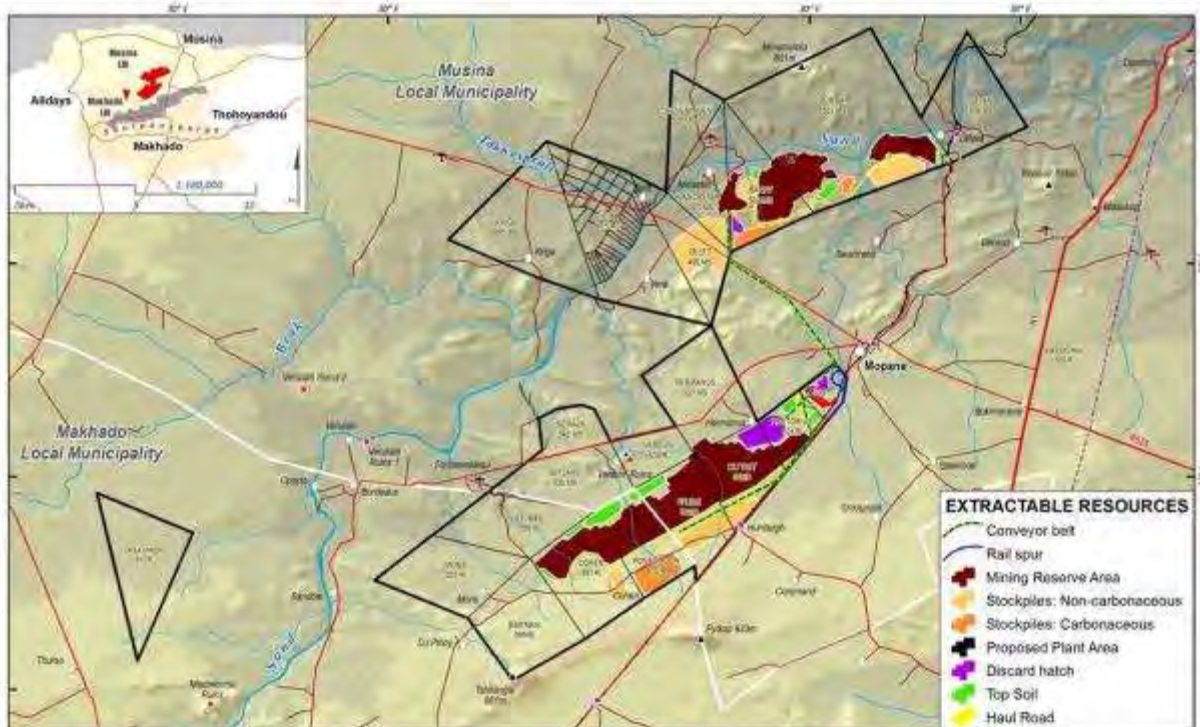

## Bulk Water Sources



- Relocation of the Mopane Infrastructure Hub to either the farm Van Der Bijl 528 MS or the farm Vriendin 589 MS
- Re-alignment of the RoM conveyor from the Voorburg Section to the Infrastructure Hub, aligning it along the Nieuwelust road and then along the Musina-Makhado railway line, rather than cutting through undisturbed areas on the farm Goosen 580 MS
- These options will be evaluated during the Pre-Feasibility studies

- MbeuYashu has conducted studies recently, on an indicative level wrt the anticipated water requirements per project, which has been benchmarked in the industry
- The company has appointed highly qualified and experienced engineers to conduct water sourcing studies to determine the level and extent of the impact
- MbeuYashu continues to do studies as the company engages with its stakeholders as the process moves towards pre-feasibility and feasibility. During this phase all studies that are necessary and appropriate will be conducted, on a local (project) as well as regional level

## Logistics – raw coal and final product



Eskom is establishing the following Distribution and Transmission assets to cater for load north of the Soutpansberg:

- Establish Bokmakierie Distribution station
  - Although the Bokmakierie Substation is not yet built, it has received an Environmental Authorisation for the building of a Distribution Substation for the new 132 kV power line that has recently been established. The Bokmakierie Substation will be built on the Farm Scott 567MS Portion 2.
- Establish 4 x 250 MVA 400/132 kV Nzhelele Main Transmission Station (MTS)

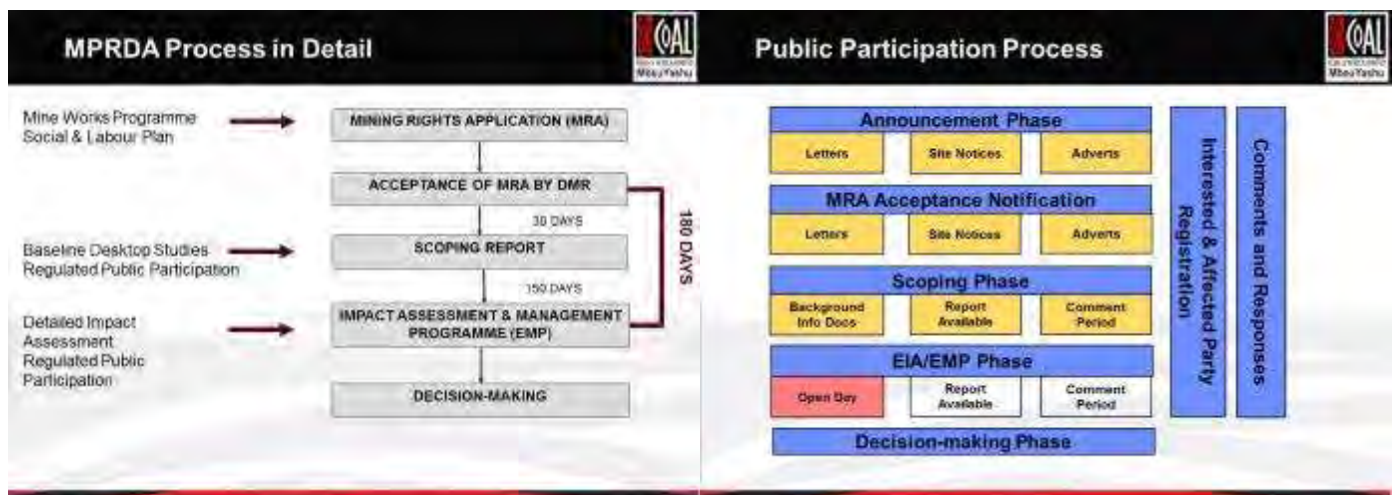
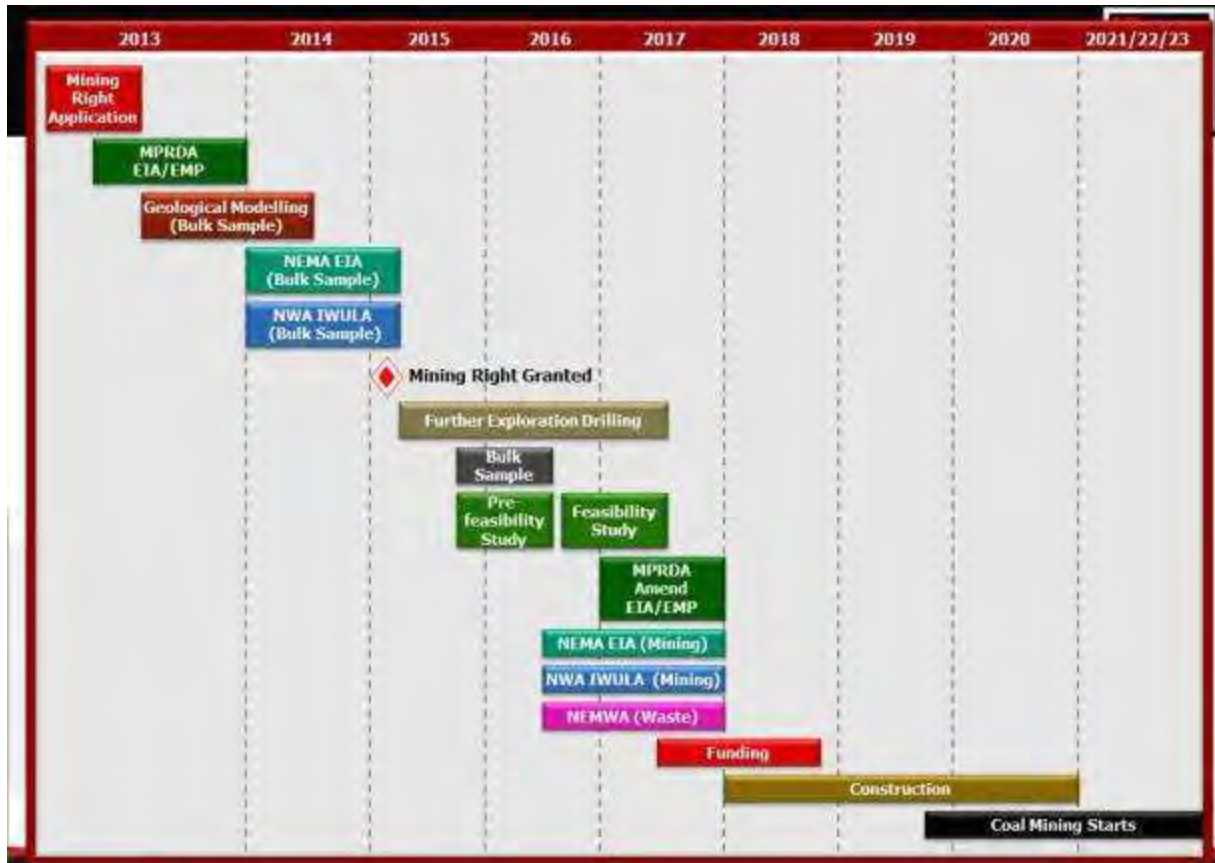
- The washing plant will be situated next to the main Transnet railway line which eliminates road transport for final product

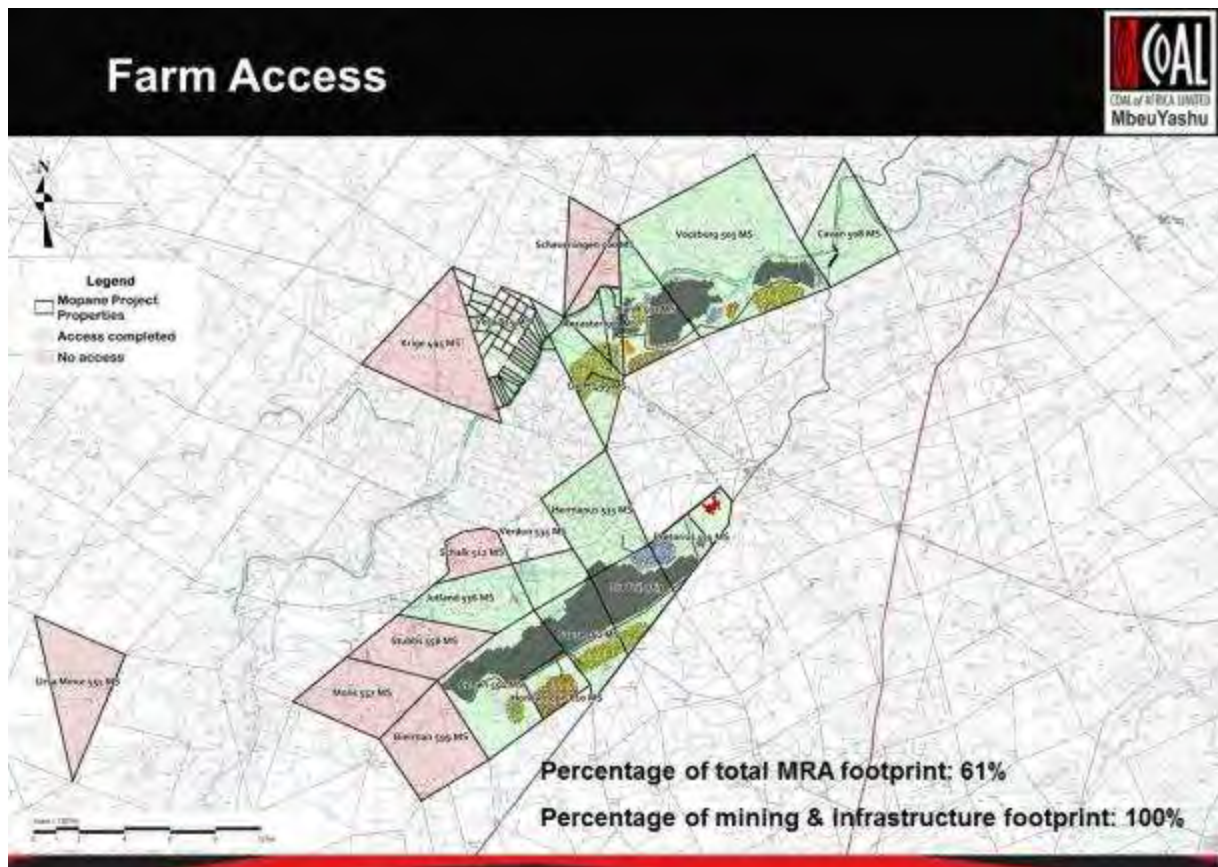

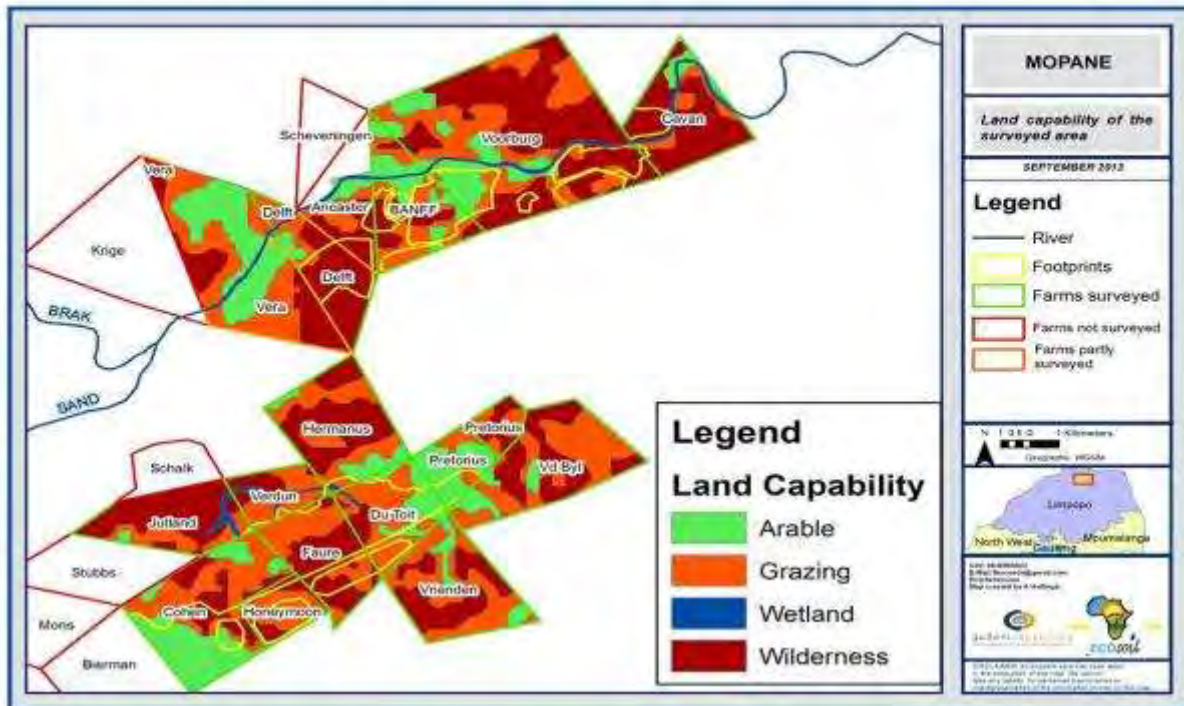

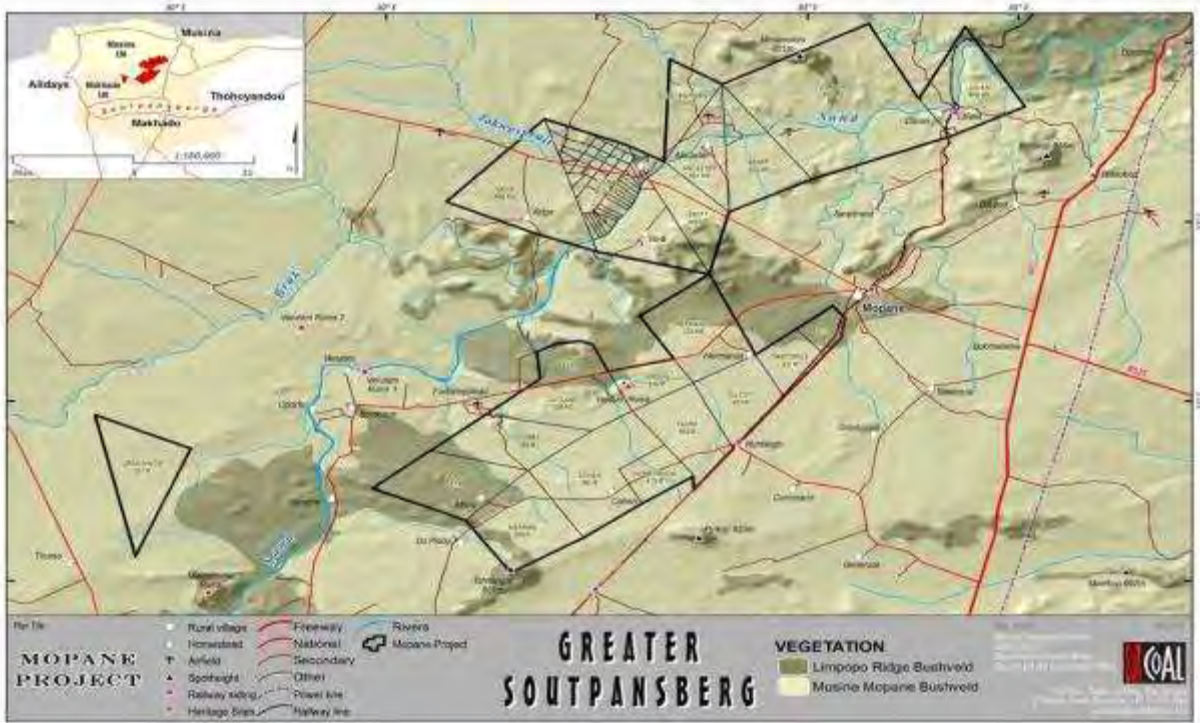
## Soil Impact Assessment



- Generally the soils are severely degraded through erosion and topsoil loss.
- The majority of area has a poor basal cover, and it is prone to compaction and crust formation.
- A large percentage of the area has very shallow and rocky soils as well as surface rock outcrops.
- The majority of soils are not high potential arable soils and have low soil fertility. This has the implication that rehabilitation will be complex and special measures need to be implemented to prevent soil loss through wind and water erosion.
- Water for irrigation purposes is already of poor quality. Special measures should be put in place to protect surface and sub-surface water sources from further contamination.

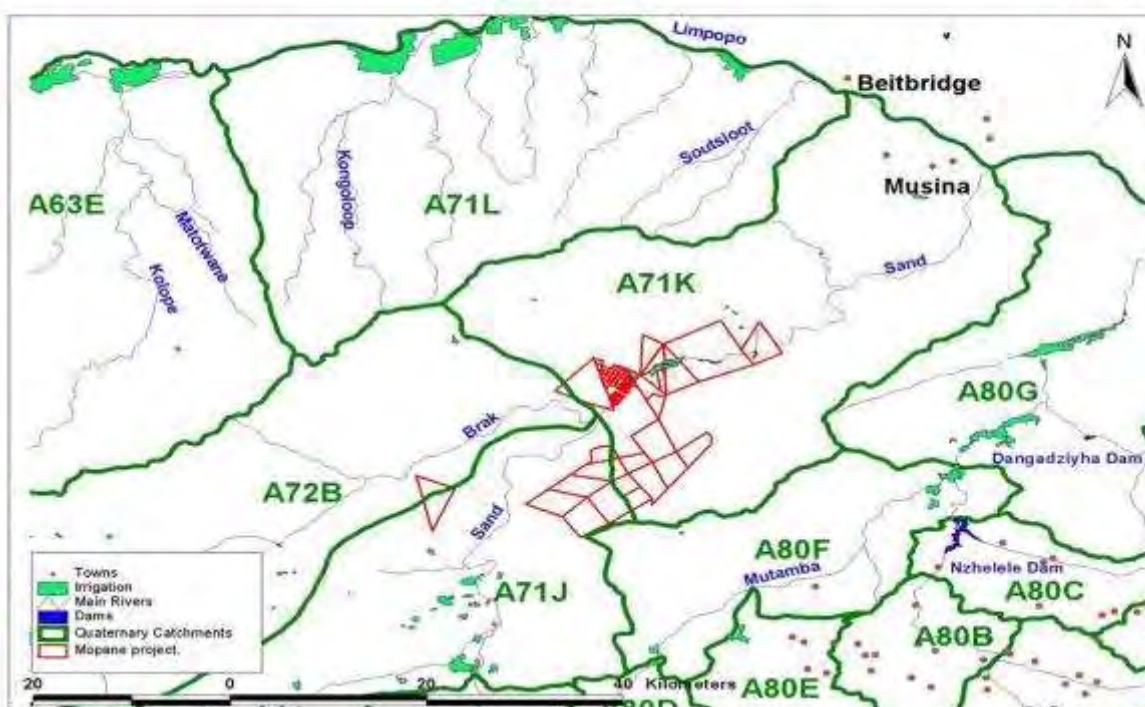
# Biodiversity Impact Assessment

- **Flora**
  - Loss of vegetation (3500 ha out of 21000 ha)
  - Loss of floral species of special concern
  - Increased risk of alien invasion
  - Increased risk of soil erosion

  - Aridification of the area as a result of mine de-watering

# Surface Water Catchment

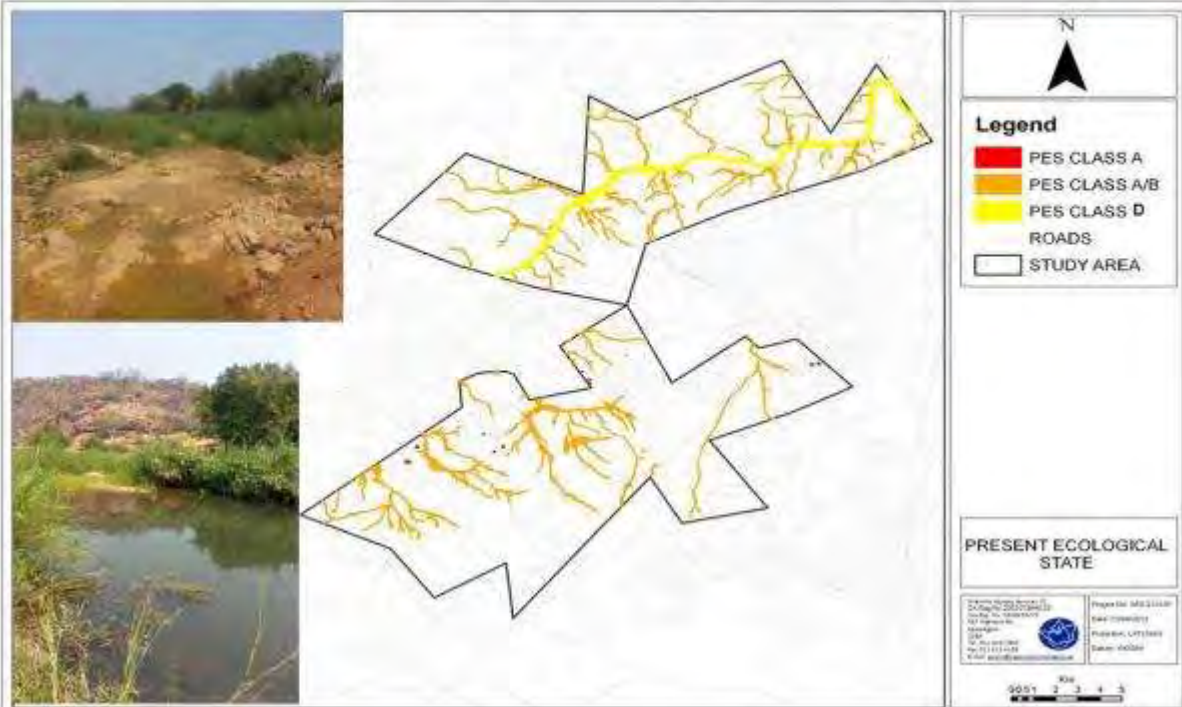

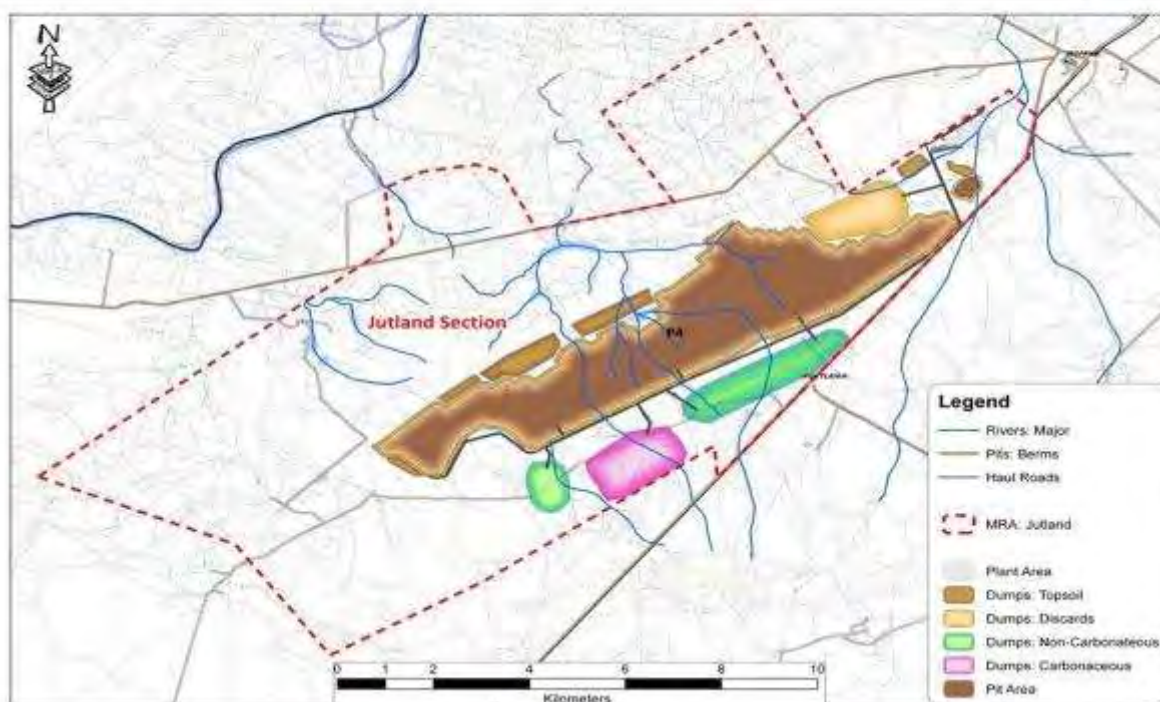

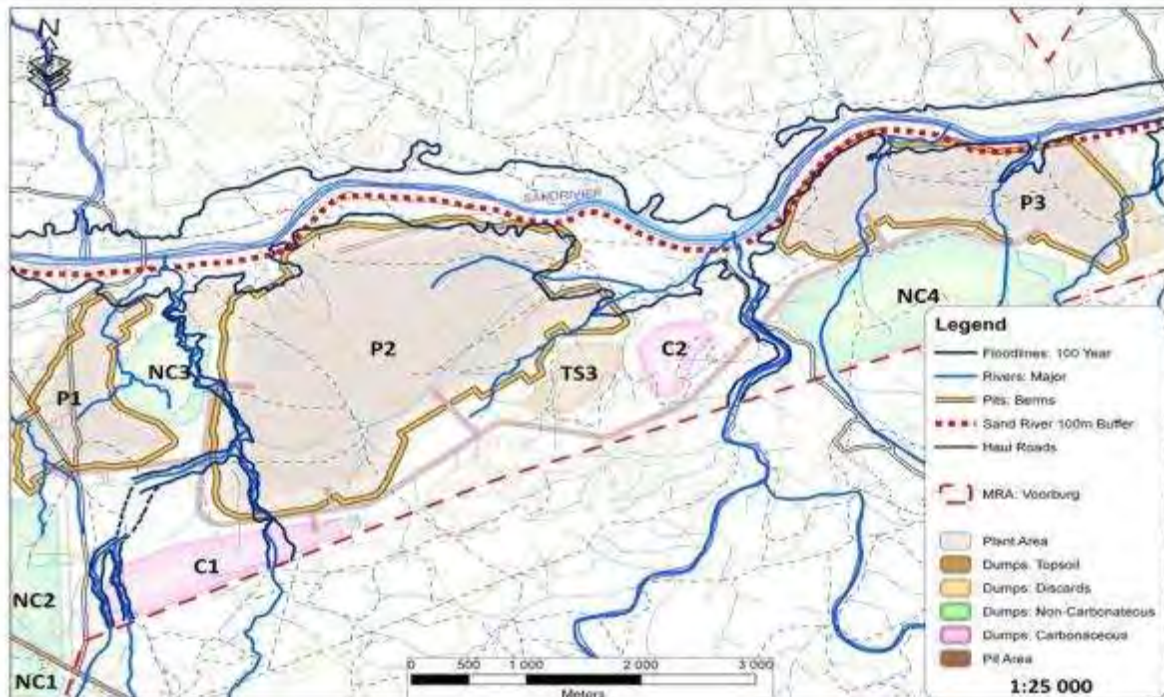

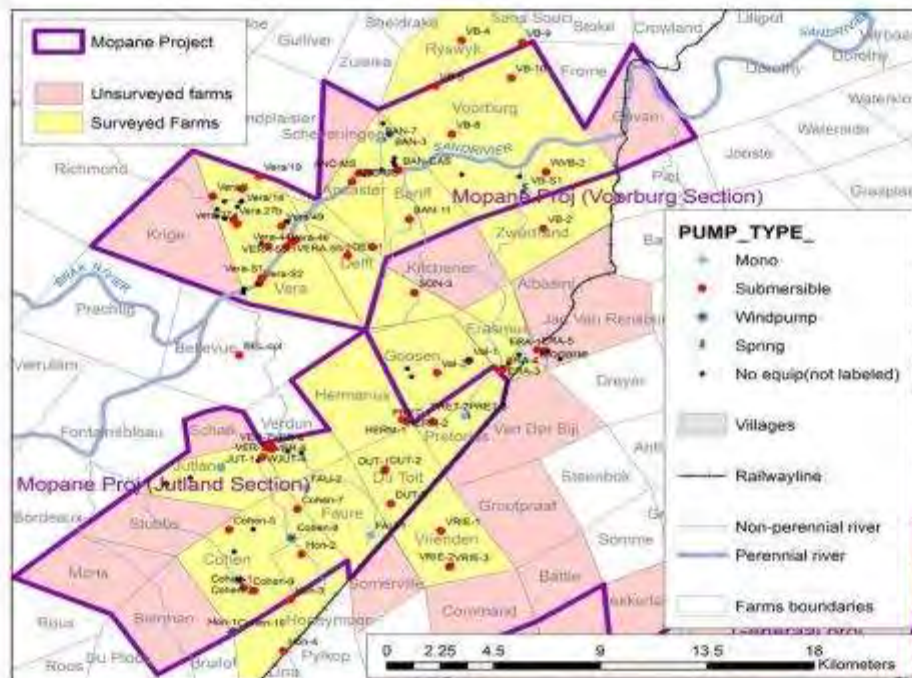


## Other Surface Water Risks

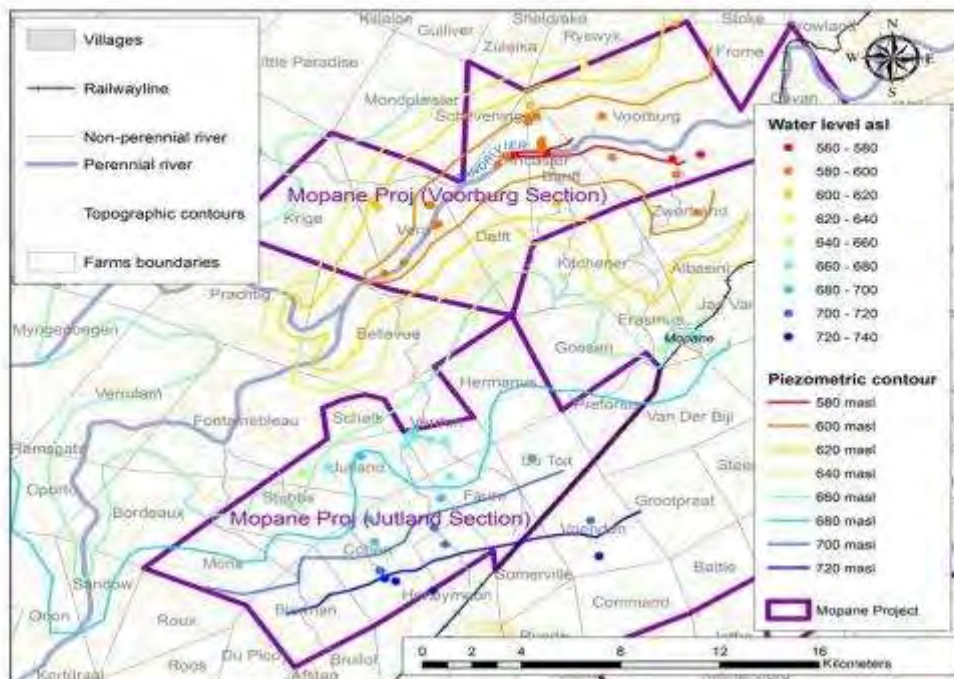
- Water quality: in the operational phase only major events or failures in the storm water management system will lead to pollution. In the long term, decant may occur which will cause pollution
- Hydrocarbon spills: outside of the areas where special precautions are taken, spills may occur, e.g. engine failure leaking oil
- Spillage of product may occur from the railway and conveyor systems



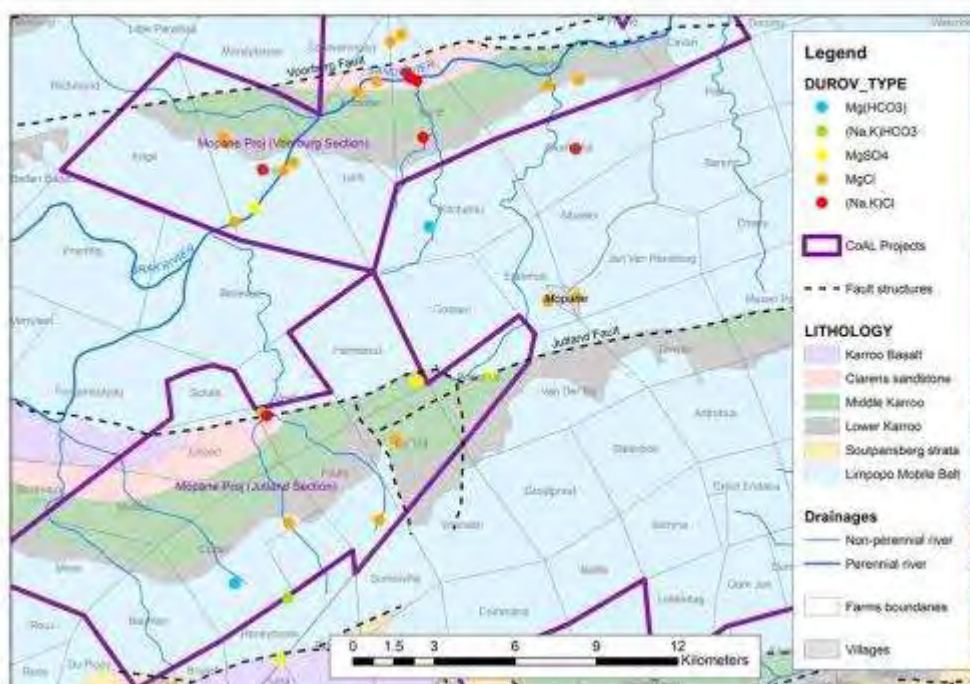

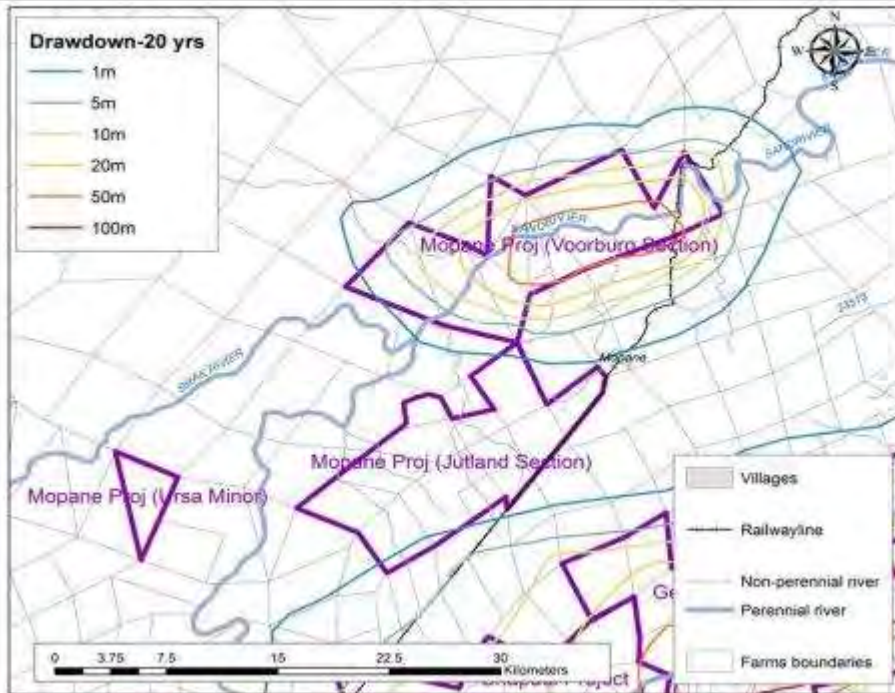
## Groundwater – Conceptual Model



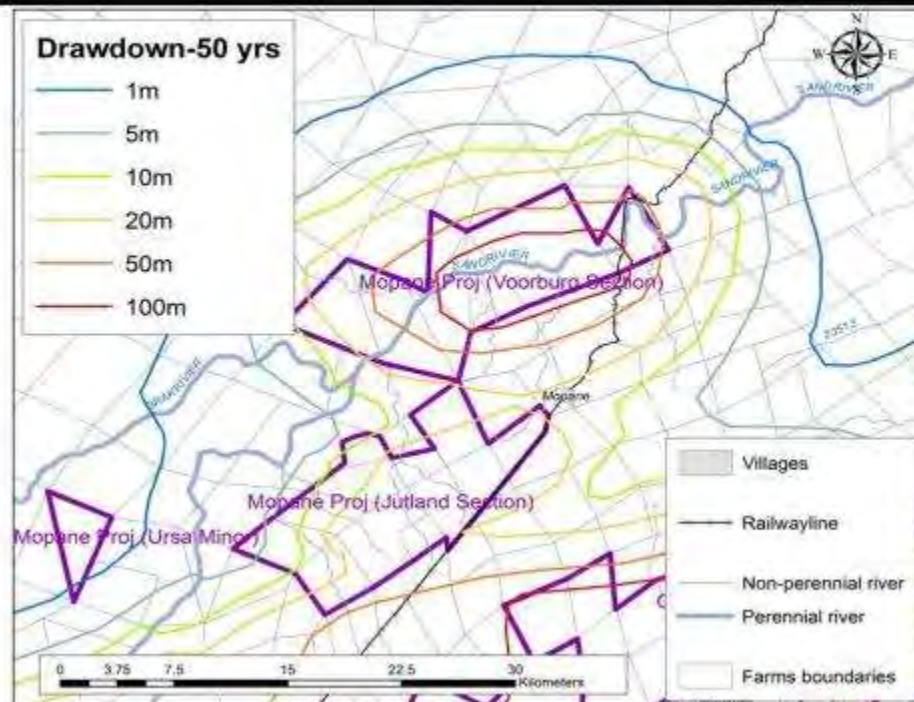
Based on:

- Known geological and hydrogeological features
- Permeabilities and storativities of the geological formations
- Recharge to the aquifers and its variability
- Static water levels/piezometric heads of the study area
- Extent to which intended activities will interact with the geology and hydrogeology on the region so that lateral and vertical boundaries of concern can be identified
- Identification of the processes and interactions taking place that influence the movement of groundwater, such as evapotranspiration from riverine zones, abstraction from boreholes, springs and base flow to streams and rivers

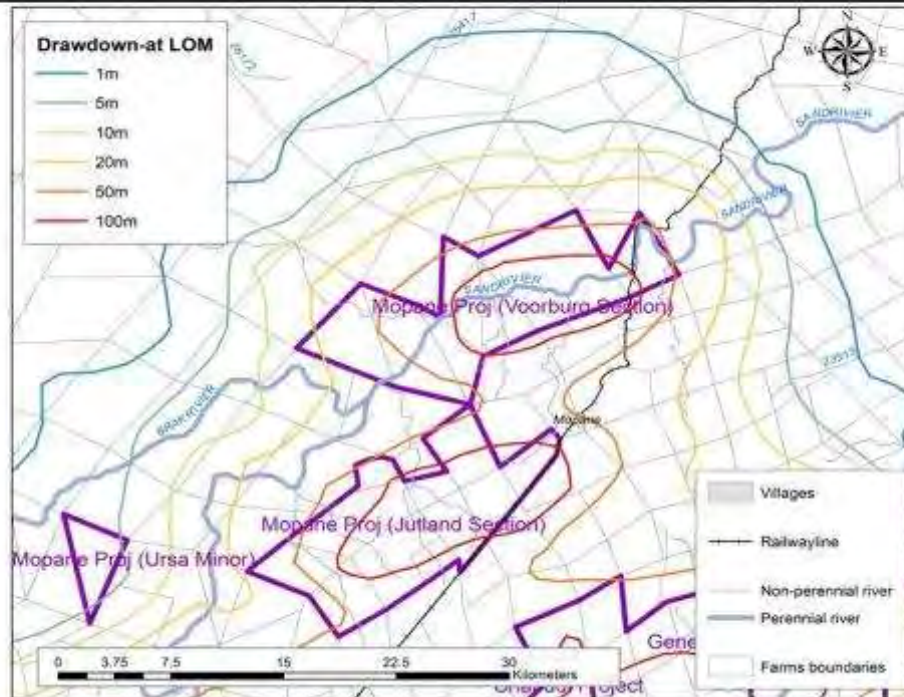
# Potential Impact on Groundwater – 20 years



# Potential Impact on Groundwater – 50 years





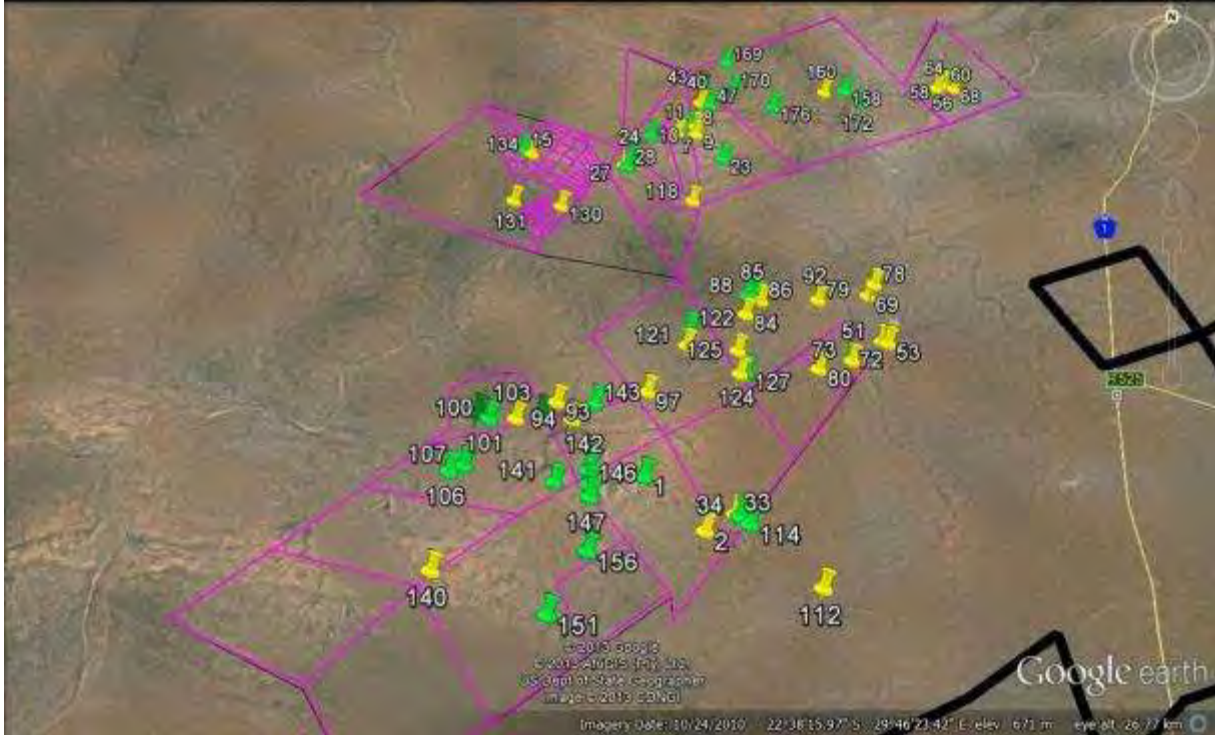

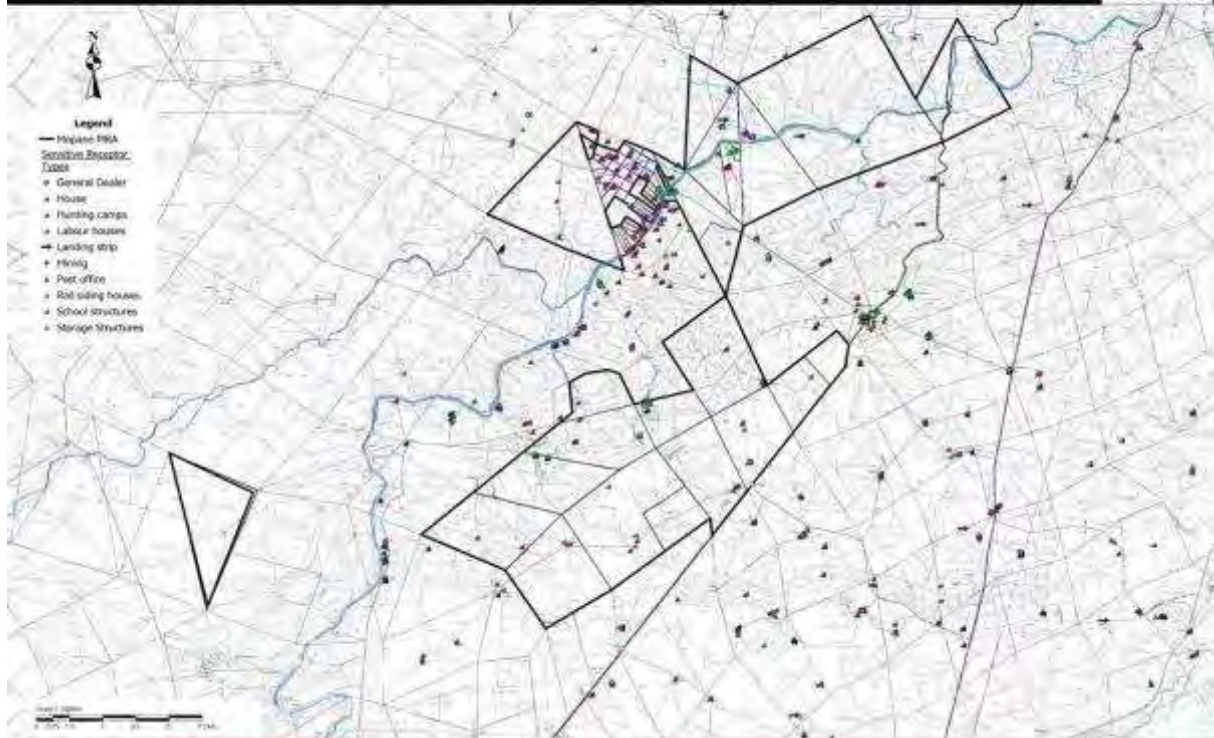

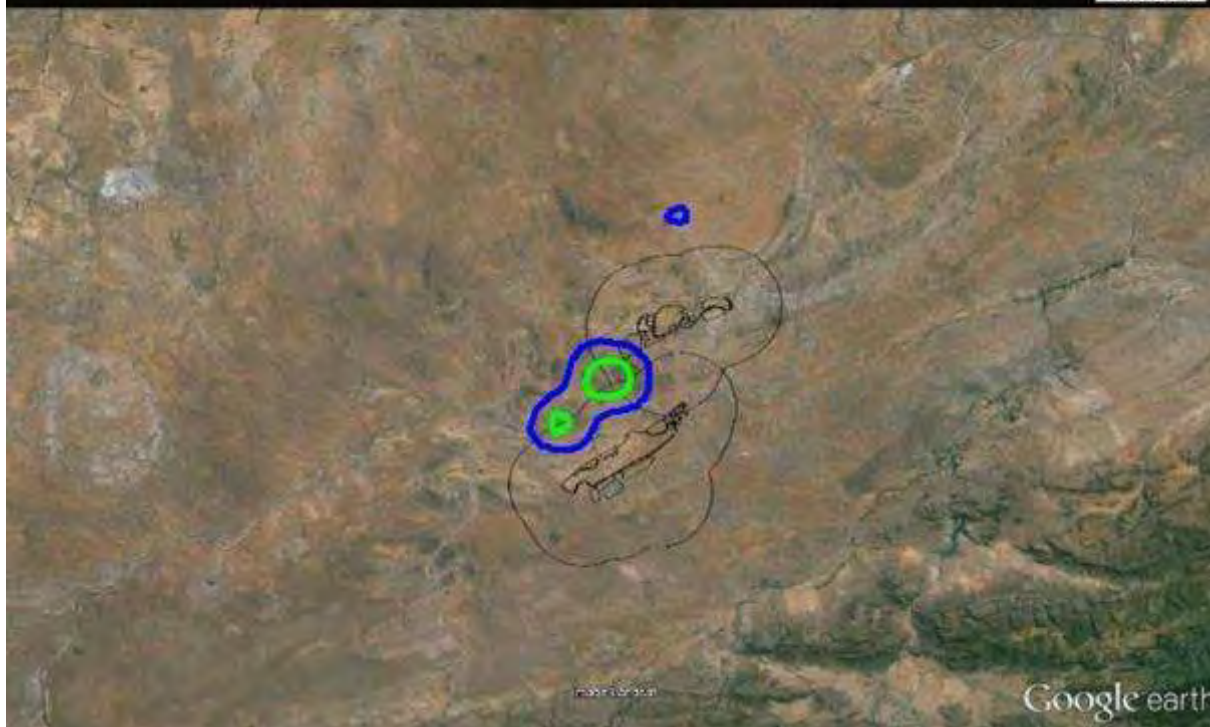

## Economic Cost Benefit analysis

- The results show that although there will be localized impacts, the project is economically viable (will have a positive socio-economic impact) for the country and province

## Potential Socio-Economic Aspects

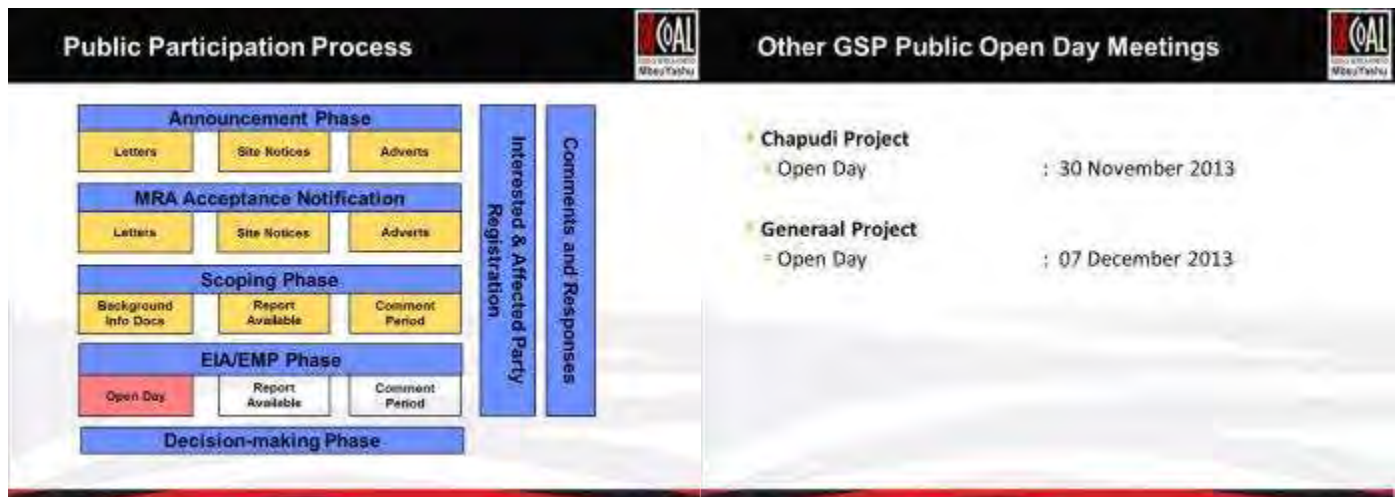




