DOBV is die bevoegde owerheid wat die omgewingmagtiging uitreik vir hierdie voorgestelde ontwikkeling. Ander lisensies en permitte kan moontlik benodig word en aansoek kan gedoen word vir 'n Oseaan Strand Huur Permit van CapeNature en 'n Water Licensie van die Department van Menselike Nedersettings, Water & Sanitasie (DMNW&S).

He says he feels blessed to have


opened the nine restaurants over the past nine years.
