WKN-WindCurrent ('WKN') under the SPV, Paulputs WEF (RF) (Pty) Ltd, received environmental

authorisation for the Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (WEF) on 11 December 2019, DEFF Reference No. 14/12/16/3/3/2/1160.

Paulputs WEF is currently authorised for a maximum of 75 wind turbines with a total generation capacity of 300 MW, each with a maximum hub height of 140 m (rotor diameter height 180 m), one on-site substation (Option A) and an Overhead Power Line (grid connection) (Option C). Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (RE) (Pty) Ltd are proposing **to amend and split** the authorised Paulputs WEF into Paulputs North WEF and Paulputs South WEF.

**Two EA amendment applications** will be submitted to the DEFF (the Competent Authority). The Applicants (Paulputs North WEF (Pty) Ltd and Paulputs South WEF (Pty) Ltd) will request that the Department consider issuing <a href="mailto:three-separate Environmental Authorisations">three-separate Environmental Authorisations</a> for the amendments.

A Separate Basic Assessment process and Environmental Authorisation Application will be undertaken to authorise (1) a grid connection Option and (2) an on-site substation option for Paulputs South WEF. Paulputs South WEF (Pty) Ltd will request that the Department consider issuing two separate Environmental Authorisations for the Basic Assessment.

# MOTIVATION AS PER REGULATION 11 OF THE NEMA EIA REGULATIONS (AS AMENDED) TO COMBINE THE BASIC ASSESSMENT APPLICATION FOR THE PAULPUTS WIND ENERGY FACILITY SOUTH SUBSTATION AND ITS ASSOCIATED GRID CONNECTION

REQUEST TO ISSUE TWO SEPARATE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATIONS AS PART OF ONE BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT AND APPLICATION.

WKN-WindCurrent ('WKN') under the SPV, Paulputs WEF (RF) (Pty) Ltd, received environmental authorisation for the Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (WEF) on 11 December 2019, DEFF Reference No. 14/12/16/3/3/2/1160. Paulputs WEF is currently authorised for a maximum of 75 wind turbines with a total generation capacity of 300 MW, each with a maximum hub height of 140 m (rotor diameter height 180 m), one on-site substation (Option A) and an Overhead Power Line (grid connection) (Option C).

Two separate Part II Amendment Application is being undertaken to split the authorised Paulputs WEF into (1) Paulputs WEF North and (2) Paulputs WEF South - divided by the N14 National Highway. This letter addresses the Basic Assessment undertaken in respect of a 132 kV on-site substation and 132 kV Grid Connection for the Paulputs WEF South.

Paulputs Wind Energy Facility South (Pty) Ltd ('Paulputs WEF South') are proposing the construction and operation of:

- Paulputs WEF South 132 kV, double circuit, loop-in/loop-out Grid Connection
- Paulputs WEF South 4 Ha on-site substation and battery storage.

Both the 132 kV grid connection and on-site substation were assessed as part of the approved Paulputs WEF (Reference No. 14/12/16/3/3/2/1160), however the DEA:DEFF only considered the preferred alternative for the approval of the EA. The Applicant appeals to the DEA:DEFF to consider allowing for a combined Environmental Authorisation (EA) Application and Basic Assessment report to be submitted in terms of Regulation 11 (3) and Regulation 11 (4).

**Regarding Regulation 11 (3 and 4) Motivation:** The Applicant intends to undertake activities triggered in respect of the on-site substation, as well as activities triggered in respect of the grid connection, within the same development, of which both are located on the Paulputs WEF South site. The grid connection will terminate at the Paulputs Eskom Substation. The proposed development of the on-site substation and grid connection are interrelated - the development of one may not proceed without the other. Combining the on-site substation and grid connection into a single basic assessment report will be preferable to simplify the EA Application process.

Following the above motivation, the Applicant would require the receipt of separate EA's, as the Grid Connection EA is expected to be transferred to Eskom after construction of the overhead powerline.



Impacts (including cumulative impacts) in respect of the on-site substation and grid connection have already been assessed as part of the Approved Paulputs WEF. For the submission of this basic assessment application, the original assessments undertaken by independent specialists (August 2019) have been revisited and verified. Verification letters will be submitted, alongside the original assessments, with this basic assessment report.

#### **Conclusion:**

In conclusion, the Department can expect the submission of one basic assessment EA application, for which two separate Environmental Authorisations is requested.



and

"If one or more proponents intend undertaking interrelated activities at the same or different locations within the area of jurisdiction of a competent authority, the competent authority may, in writing, agree that the proponent or proponents submit a single application in respect of all of those activities and to conduct a consolidated assessment process but the potential environmental impacts of each activity, including its cumulative impacts, must be considered in terms of the location where the activity is to be undertaken" Furthermore; the applicant must comply with Regulation 11(5) of the EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended, which states that:

 "Where a combined application is submitted as contemplated in these Regulations, the proponent must, prior to submission of the application, confirm with the competent authority the fee payable in terms of the applicable regulations for such combined application"




Figure 2. Satellite image map of the project layout.

The Directorate: Biodiversity Conservation reviewed and evaluated the aforementioned draft report.

Based on the information provided in the report, the northern section of the powerline intersects with a designated Critical Biodiversity Areas (CBA) 2 and the southern end with a designated Critical Biodiversity Areas (CBA) 1. Developments within CBA 1 are not permitted as are regarded as areas that are irreplaceable or near irreplaceable for meeting biodiversity targets unless being transformed, but in CBA 2 developments are considered to be favorable and suitable as they fall within medium or low area. Therefore, no fatal flaws are to be anticipated as the footprint within these areas will be restricted to pylon footprints only and will be minor in the area.

Notwithstanding the above, the following recommendations must be considered in the final report:

- Final walk-through of the approved development footprint must be conducted to ensure that sensitive habitats and species are avoided where possible.
- Search and rescue plan must be developed for confirmation of those species that have a high probability of occurrence and which will be impacted by the proposed development.
- Any protected plant species must not be removed or damaged prior to obtaining permit from relevant National or Provincial Authorities.
- Sensitive habitats in close proximity to the development footprint must be avoided or demarcated as No-Go area i.e. Nests and Kaboep River.

- Suitable bird repelling structures and bird diverters must be considered to avoid collision of birds with the infrastructure.

Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (RF) (Pty) Ltd ('PWEF'), a wholly owned subsidiary of WKN Windcurrent SA (Pty) Ltd, was granted environmental authorisation for the 300MW (75 turbines) Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (WEF) and its associated 132kV OHPL on 11 December 2019 by the Department Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE) (Reference No. 14/12/16/3/3/2/1120). As part of the original Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), three alternative OHPL options (A, B and C) and three alternative onsite substation options (A, B and C) were assessed. The Competent Authority (CA), DEFF, chose to only issue a favourable authorisation for the preferred OHPL option 'C' and onsite substation option 'A''.

To comply with the Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (REIPPPP) bidding requirements, the abovementioned 300MW Paulputs WEF is being split into the 150MW Paulputs South WEF and the 150MW Paulputs North WEF (being split as part of a separate amendment application). The authorised OHPL option 'C' and on-site substation option 'A' will be used for Paulputs North WEF and a new authorisation for additional electrical infrastructure is now required to connect Paulputs South WEF to the National Grid.

In effect of the above, Paulputs South (the Applicant) intend to apply for two separate Environmental Authroisations for the construction and operation of the proposed development, which includes: A 132 kV, double circuit, loop-in/loop-out Grid Connection and 4.4 ha substation yard comprising: 1.2 ha on-site substation, 1 ha for offices, 1.2ha battery energy storage systems (BESS), and 1 ha permanent laydown area.

On 03 August 2021, a combined application for both the grid connection and substation was submitted, and two separate Environmental Authorisation reference numbers was requested from the DFFE. The DFFE acknowledged this application in compliance with the NEMA EIA Regulations on 04 August 2021. The same day, this application was then rejected siting that a combined application could not be accepted. As a result, Arcus have resubmitted the same reports and appendices, however split the combined application into two:

- Application One: A 132 kV, double circuit, loop-in/loop-out Grid Connection; and
- **Application Two:** 4.4 ha substation yard comprising: 1.2 ha on-site substation, 1 ha for offices, 1.2ha battery energy storage systems (BESS), and 1 ha permanent laydown area

# **Listed Activities**

- You are required to provide the voltage of electricity to be processed in the substation as it relates to activity 11 of listing Notice 1 and must be reflected on page 12 of 33 of the application form.
- On page 12 of the application form in the description of the project activity that triggers the listed activity that relates to activity 14 of Listing Notice 1 and activity 10 of Listing Notice 3, the word "may" is used in relation to the volume of dangerous goods to be stored in the Battery Energy Storage System (BESS). Refrain from using the word "may" rather the word "will" should be used.
- It has been noted that activity 14 of Listing Notice 1 as it relates to BESS is applied for even though BESS is not regarded as a facility or infrastructure for the storage or storage and handling of a dangerous goods. Please explain the reasons for applying for this activity.
- In listed activities 4, 10, 12 and 18 of Listing Notice 3, the sub activities "(ee) Critical biodiversity areas as identified in systematic biodiversity plans adopted by the competent authority or in bioregional plans and (ii) Within critical biodiversity areas identified in bioregional plans" are applied for. You are required to confirm whether or not there is a systematic biodiversity plan or a bioregional plan adopted by the Member of Executive Council of the Northern Cape Provincial Department of Environment and Nature Conservation.
- Please ensure that all relevant listed activities are applied for, are specific and can be linked to the
  development activity or infrastructure as described in the project description. Only activities applicable to
  the development must be applied for and assessed.

If the activities applied for in the application form differ from those mentioned in the final BAR, an amended
application form must be submitted. Please note that the Department's application form template has been
amended and can be downloaded from the following linkhttps://www.environment.gov.za/documents/forms.

# **Project details**

- It has been noted on page iii under executive summary that the Applicant is expecting the Department to issue 2 (two) separate environmental authorisation for overhead power line and substation including BESS. Taking into consideration there are separate applications (Ref. No 14/12/16/3/3/1/2417 and 14/12/16/3/3/1/2418) already submitted, you are advised to correct the aforesaid information and clearly indicate what is expected from the Department.
- You are required to clearly indicate the technical details and other details that are applicable to this application i.e. project description, location, listed activities and conditions recommended for inclusion in the environmental authorisation.

# **Alternatives**

- On page iv under the summary of the consideration of alternatives of the draft BAR, it is indicated that "Layout Alternatives: The preferred layout of the OHPL and substation was assessed as part of the authorised Paulputs WEF EIA (Arcus, 2019)" however this development does not include an overhead power line, therefore, you are required to provide a layout alternative that is relevant to this development as per the requirements of Appendix 1(3)(1)(h)(i). In addition, you are reminded that the components applied for in this application i.e. on-site substation and BESS and its location were not part of the aforesaid application. Therefore, you are advised to refrain from referring to the previous application and ensure impacts for these structures are adequately identified, assessed and measures are included in the final report.
- In terms of Appendix 1 (3) (1) (g) and (h)(v)(viii) of NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended, you are required to indicate the preferred technology alternative for BESS. Additionally, risks associated with each technology must be specified and mitigation measures to manage those risks must be provided and included in the final BAR and EMPr.

# **Specialist Assessment**

- It has been noted that the two screening tool reports titled "Paulputs WEF Part II Amendments" and "Basic Assessment for the Proposed Paulputs South WEF Substation and BESS" are appended to this application. Ensure that the correct screening report is appended to the application.
- Additionally, the correct screening report will inform the specialist studies to be conducted as part of this
  application.
- On the screening tool report titled "Basic Assessment for the Proposed Paulputs South WEF Substation and BESS" the project site has a sensitivity rating of low for aquatic biodiversity theme as such a compliance statement must be compiled as per the requirements of GN320 of 20 March 2020.

# **Cumulative Assessment**

Should there be any other similar projects within a 35km radius of the proposed development site, the cumulative impact assessment for all identified and assessed impacts must be refined to indicate the following:

- Identified cumulative impacts must be clearly defined, and where possible the size of the identified impact
  must be quantified and indicated, i.e. hectares of cumulatively transformed land.
- Detailed process flow and proof must be provided, to indicate how the specialist's recommendations, mitigation measures and conclusions from the various similar developments in the area were taken into consideration in the assessment of cumulative impacts and when the conclusion and mitigation measures were drafted for this project.
- The cumulative impacts significance rating must also inform the need and desirability of the proposed development.
- A cumulative impact environmental statement on whether the proposed development must proceed.

# Recommendation and conclusion

In section 13 on page 120 of the draft BAR, it is stated that "The proposed development of a OHPL, Battery Energy Storage System and on-site substation" is required for the authorised Paulputs South WEF to provide much needed renewable energy to the country's grid", however the Paulputs South WEF has not been authorised rather Paulputs Wind Energy Facility is authorised. Ensure that this statement is corrected in the final BAR.

# Layout and sensitivity map

- The Department has noted that a layout plan has not been provided for the proposed development instead a map titled Paulputs South Grid connection site sensitivity is provided (Figure 11.1), therefore, ensure that a layout plan at an appropriate scale for the proposed development is attached to the final BAR. The layout plan must indicate the following:
  - All onsite infrastructure (existing and proposed);
  - The location of sensitive environmental features on site, e.g., wetlands, drainage lines etc. that will be affected:
  - Buffer areas; and all "no-go" areas;
  - o The above map must be overlain with a sensitivity map.
  - o Must have clear legend that communicate with the details on the map.

# Locality map

It has been noted that a locality map titled "Paulputs South WEF Grid, substation and BESS" is appended to the BAR, however, a locality map that is relevant to this application and which depicts all the activities applied for must be appended to the final BAR.

# **Environmental Management Programme**

- The Department has noted that a generic EMPr for the substation is appended to the draft BAR, however, the EMPr for the rest of the components of this development has not been compiled. Therefore, you are required to compile an Environmental Management Programme as required in terms of Appendix 4 of the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.
- Furthermore, ensure that the maps that attached in section 7.2 of the generic EMPr are specific to this application.
- The following documents must be appended to the EMPr: Lifecycle Battery Recycling programme/End-of-Life plan; An Emergency Response Plan; First Responder Training manual; Thermal management and monitoring programme; and BESS operations and maintenance programme.

# **Undertaking of an Oath**

- The Department has noted that the submitted application form has an undertaking under oath or affirmation by the EAP. However, the aforementioned oath was not included in the draft BAR, but rather an appendix of the application form attached to the BAR. Please note that the final BAR must also have an undertaking under oath/ affirmation by the EAP.
- Based on the above, you are therefore required to include an undertaking under oath or affirmation by the EAP (administered by a Commissioner of Oaths) as per Appendix 1(3)(r) of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, which states that the BAR must include:
  - "an undertaking under oath or affirmation by the EAP in relation to:
  - a) the correctness of the information provided in the reports;
  - b) the inclusion of comments and inputs from stakeholders and I&APs;
  - c) the inclusion of inputs and recommendations from the specialist reports where relevant; and
  - d) any information provided by the EAP to interested and affected parties and any responses by the EAP to comments or inputs made by interested and affected parties".
