Noise Impact Assessment: Minor changes to the Paulputs Wind Energy Facility – Part II Amendments

It is understood that a number of minor changes are proposed to the Authorised Paulputs Wind Energy Facility (WEF), primarily aimed at splitting the WEF into two separate developments: Paulputs North WEF (up to 40 turbines) and Paulputs South WEF (up to 35 turbines).

As part of the original Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), three alternative Grid Connection options (A, B and C) and three alternative on-site substation options (A, B and C) were assessed. The Competent Authority (CA), Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE), chose to only issue a favourable authorisation for the preferred Grid Connection option 'C' and on-site substation option 'A'. In order to serve Paulputs South WEF, an application is being made for an additional substation in the same location as the of the previously assessed Substation optional location C of the Paulputs WEF, with associated Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) and grid connection.

As such, this substation, grid connection and BESS is being dealt with through a separate Authorisation. The purpose of this letter is to demonstrate that the noise impact due to these additional plant items is not significant, and therefore does not require a detailed Basic Assessment Report (BAR). The noise impact associated with each item is discussed below:

Substation and BESS:

The substation location was considered as a potential option in the original Paulputs WEF assessment (substation location C), and found to be acceptable. Noise from the inclusion of a BESS will be limited to a small number of air-conditioning units to regulate the temperature of the batteries. Given the substantial separation distance from location C to residential dwellings (approximately 2.6 km from the closest residential dwelling), and the fact that the substation / BESS location is located within the authorised wind turbines, noise from the substation and BESS will be inaudible at residential dwellings. It will therefore have no impact in terms of noise.

Grid Connection:

The grid connection route was considered as a potential option in the original Paulputs WEF assessment (grid connection option A). As stated in that assessment, transmission lines are generally silent, with any noise limited to a phenomenon known as corona noise.

Corona noise is caused by the partial breakdown of the insulation properties of air surrounding the conducting wires. It can generate an audible and radio-frequency noise, but is of a low level, and generally only occurs in humid conditions as provided by fog or rain.

Corona discharges result in:

Power losses;



- Audible noises:
- Electromagnetic interference;
- A purple glow;
- Ozone production; and
- Insulation damage

As such, Electrical Service Providers go to great lengths to design power transmission equipment to minimise the formation of corona discharges. It is an infrequent occurrence requiring a specific and relatively uncommon set of weather conditions and is of a short duration compared to other operational noises.

The proposed grid connection will be silent for the majority of the time, and even in the event of corona noise being generated, is highly likely to be inaudible at residential dwellings. It will therefore have no impact in terms of noise.

Conclusion:

The proposals will not result in any additional noise impact relative to that already assessed and Authorised for the Paulputs WEF. No further noise studies are therefore required to be undertaken, and the proposal is not significant in terms of the EIA Regulations.
