

## **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS**

Provides a description of the Public Participation Process followed.

### **1. PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT**

A public participation process was undertaken in accordance with the **EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended)**

The public participation and communication process aims to identify issues in order to maximise the social and environmental benefits, and to minimise the social and environmental costs of the proposed project. All interested and affected parties (I&APs) were consulted and afforded the opportunity to participate. I&APs were informed and involved in the project from the outset in order to promote participation and transparency.

The aim of this public participation process is to achieve the following broad goals:

- Identification of all key I&APs and stakeholders;
- The active involvement of all I&APs with respect to decision making;
- Exchange of information relevant to the proposed project through Background Information Documents (BID), site notices, consultations and newspaper advertisements.
- The development of an understanding with regards to the broader project objectives and goals and knowledge of the project; and
- The identification of issues and concerns with regards to all potential alternatives associated with the proposed development.

## **2. APPROACH TO UNDERTAKING THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS**

The following approach was followed in undertaking the public participation process:

### **2.1 Identification of and Consultation with I&APs**

The first step in the public participation process is normally to identify the key I&APs. Key I&APs include:

- The landowner on whose property the development is to take place.
- Traditional leaders
- Landowners adjacent to the proposed site and in the immediate area;
- Mogalakwena Local Municipality;
- Ward Councillors from the Mogalakwena Local Municipality
- Waterberg District Municipality;
- The National Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment
- The Department of Water and Sanitation
- The Limpopo Province Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism
- The Limpopo Heritage Resources Authority (LIHRA)
- SAHRA

Letters from liaison with these I &APs and the Local Authorities are attached.

## **2.2 Background Information Document (BID)**

A BID was compiled in December 2022 . The aim of this document was to provide a brief outline of the proposed project, provide preliminary details regarding the Basic Assessment Report process, and explaining how I&APs can become involved in the project. The BID was forwarded to all registered interested and affected parties.

A copy of the BID is included.

## **2.3 Advertising**

In accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended advertisements were placed in the local/regional newspaper requesting I&APs to register their interest in the project. An advertisements was placed in the local newspaper, The Mokopane Express of 17 – 25 January 2023. The Mokopane Express is widely distributed in the Mokopane region. The commenting period was 30 days.

Copies of the advertisement is included.

## **2.5 Site notices**

Site notifications in English in A2 format requesting comments or objections were erected at the Mogalakwena and Mahwereleng public libraries as well as on site at the start, centre and end of the project.

A copy of the site notice is included.

## **2.6 Comments and Response Report**

A comments and response report was drafted that will include all the issues raised by the Interested and/or Affected Parties as well as the responses to the issues raised. A copy of the Comments and Response report is included.

## **2.7 List of Registered I&AP's**

A list of registered Interested and Affected Parties were compiled and is included.

## **3. LOCAL AUTHORITY INVOLVEMENT**

A stakeholder meeting with management of the Mogalakwena Local Municipality and Ward Councillors of the affected wards, requested by Chameleon Environmental and the Applicant, was arranged and took place on 13 December 2022 at the Mogalakwena Local Municipality council chambers. Each attendee was issued with a copy of the BID and locality plan of the project. The environmental authorisation process was discussed and attendees were presented with an opportunity to raise questions and issues. As this meeting was preceded by Land Rights Holders resolution meetings arranged by the Applicant and Department of Rural Development and Land reform at various venues within the local communities along the proposed route, all attendees were well aware of the proposed project and the scope thereof. The respective local authorities will be informed of the availability of the Draft BAR . The respective local authorities will also be reminded of the closing expiry date for comments.

#### **4. LAND OWNERS NOTIFICATION**

The existing road reserve (National road N11 Section 13) is the property of the State. SANRAL is an Organ of the State and also the Applicant. All affected land owners along the route have been notified of the proposed project by the Applicant, through the appointed property service provider, PropSol JV and negotiations pertaining land acquisition is ongoing. #### **5. REVIEW OF THE DRAFT BAR REPORT**

The Draft Basic Assessment Report will be made available for public review and comment for a period of 30 days. All registered I&AP's, stakeholders, commenting and competent authorities will be made aware of the availability of the document and the venue for access to the document. Copies of the Draft BAR will be displayed at the Mogalakwena and Mahwereleng Public Libraries respectively. Copies of the Draft BAR will be submitted to the following institutions for comments:

- The National Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment,
- The Department of Water and Sanitation

- The Limpopo Province Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism
- The Limpopo Heritage Resources Authority
- Mogalakwena Hills Local Municipality;
- Waterberg District Municipality;

The involvement of the public and I&APs is an important part of the BAR process. Comments on the Draft BAR will be included in the Final BAR to be submitted to the DFFE for authorisation.

## **6. WAY FORWARD**

The Final BAR will be submitted to the DFFE for authorisation.

All Interested and Affected Parties will be notified of the decision made by the competent authority and will be provided the opportunity to appeal the decision.

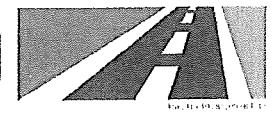
- The rehabilitation of the existing road surface by upgrading sections of the single carriageway and expanding sections of the road as dual carriageway.

- Erection of security fencing and street lighting in identified areas.
- Construction of paved sidewalks in identified areas.
- Erosion protection and landscaping.

According to the information provided to us, the affected stand (No. 63; RN20) is situated at km 4,0 (RHS). Please refer to the two layout plans attached to this e-mail.

The stand is affected by the proposed Left-in/Left-out junction from Road N11-13 to the existing bitumen-surfaced street leading to Phola Park. A portion of the stand will form part of the future road reserve of the junction and is included in the land acquisition presently in progress. It seems that no existing buildings are affected by the proposed design. Access to the stand from Road N11-23 must be obtained via the street leading to Phola Park and shall be situated on the eastern boundary of the stand. If necessary, access can also be obtained on the northern boundary of the stand from the existing internal gravel street.



Land acquisition for the road reserve and negotiations with affected land-owners are done by PropSol JV who was appointed by SANRAL for this purpose. As the land acquisition process is presently still in progress, information should be obtained from SANRAL and PropSol whether the process for the affected Stand 63 (situated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> construction project) has already been completed.
