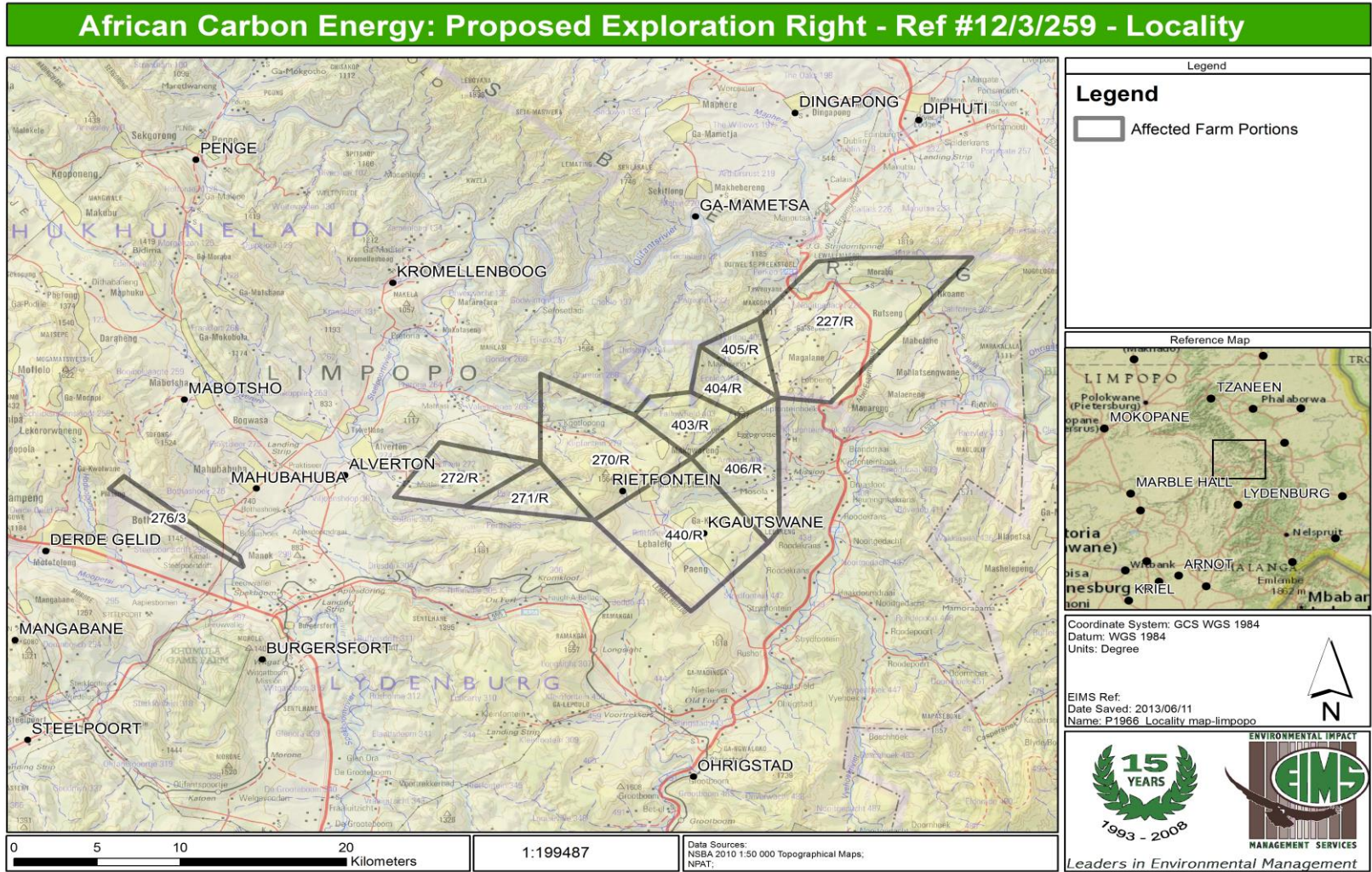
Nature of Activity:
