APPLICATION FOR A MINING PERMIT IN TERMS OF SECTION 27 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 28 OF 2002) (AS AMENDED): A PORTION OF PORTION 76 (A PORTION OF PORTION 39) OF THE FARM HAAKDOORNBOOM 267 JR; IN THE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT OF PRETORIA.

This is to inform you that your application for a mining permit in terms of section 27 of the MPRDA, (as amended) for **sand (general)** has been accepted.

In terms of section 27(5)(b) (as amended) read with regulation 52(1) of the said Act, you are therefore required to:

It only signifies that your application will be processed in order for the Minister or his delegate to consider same and make a decision within **197** days from the date of acceptance of your application.
