AMENDMENT APPLICATION FOR AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 20 MAY 2015 FOR THE PROPOSED 132kV POWERLINE ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROPOSED KORANA WIND ENERGY FACILITY ON SITE NEAR POFFADER, WITHIN KHAI-MA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN THE NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Department's decision on the above application issued on 20 May 2015, the email notification received on 20 March 2020 regarding an administrative error on the EA amendment issued on 18 March 2020, refers.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA amendment, this Department in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014, as amended, has decided to amend the administrative error; project title for the above mentioned project, as follows:

## **Amendment 1: Project title**

## From:

"The proposed construction of 4 sections of the power line and a substation called Leboeng within the Maruleng and Greater Tubatse local municipalities in Limpopo province and within the Thaba Chewu local municipality in Mpumalanga Province."

To:

"The proposed 132kV powerline associated with the proposed Korana wind energy facility on site near Pofadder, within Khai-Ma local municipality in the Northern Cape Province."

This letter must be read in conjunction with the EA amendment letter dated 20 May 2015 (as amended).

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act no. 4 of 2013) which stipulate that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuse or compromise your personal information in any way.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
