AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 07 DECEMBER 2018 FOR THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF THE 115MW SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC FACILITY VRYBURG SOLAR 3 AND ASSOCIATED ELECTRICAL INFRASTRUCTURE IN VRYBURG, NORTH WEST PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Department on 07 December 2018, and your application for amendment of the EA received by the Department on 30 October 2020, the acknowledgement letter dated 04 November 2020, the comments on the draft amendment motivation report dated 27 November 2020 and the final motivation report received on 08 December 2020, refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated 07 December 2018, as follows:

## Amendment 1: Amendment of EA holder contact details page 1 & 2:

# Amendment 2: Amendment to the project description to include Battery Energy Storage into the EA:

- b) The following is added to the infrastructure associated with the facility on page 08 of the EA:
  - "A Battery Energy Storage System with a footprint of up to 5 hectares."
  - Electrochemical battery storage systems with a maximum height of 3.5m; and Multi-core 22kV or 33kV underground cables, to follow internal access roads of the PV facility, to connect the battery storage area to the on-site facility substation.

# Amendment 3: Amendment to project description of the EA pertaining the on-site substation:

c) The following infrastructure associated with the facility on page 08 of the EA:

"On-Sites substation"

#### Is hereby amended to:

On-Sites substation and collector infrastructure.

#### Reason for amendment:

The addition of a collector infrastructure as part of the authorised on-site substation and within the authorised footprint of the substation, will allow for only one overhead power line to be developed within the area for multiple projects, and reduce the need to develop individual overhead power lines in the area for each successful project.

The amended Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) dated December 2020 is hereby approved. This EMPr must be implemented and strictly adhered to.

This proposed amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 07 December 2018.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act no. 4 of 2013) which stipulate that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuse or compromise your personal information in any way.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.

In the instance where an appeal is lodged, you may not commence with the activity until such time that the appeal is finalised.
