AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 30 AUGUST 2019 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HYPERION SOLAR DEVELOPMENT 2 WITHIN THE GAMAGARA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN THE NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE.

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Department on 30 August 2019, your application for amendment of the EA received by the Department on 13 June 2023 and the acknowledgement letter dated 14 June 2023, refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated 30 August 2019, as amended, as follows:

## Amendment 1: Change of BESS specifications.

## Reasons for the above-mentioned amendments:

The amendment is required in order to increase the storage capacity associated with the BESS and allow for it to store a sufficient amount of energy in accordance with the developer's requirements. To allow for the supply of much-needed electricity to the grid over a longer period and improve the technical feasibility of the project. The dimensions and footprint of the BESS will remain within the authorised parameters. The applicant's email address and contact number have changed. The EA, therefore, needs to be updated to reflect the correct details for easy communication.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribe the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
