

APPLICATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONCENTRATED SOLAR POWER (CSP) PLANT IN TERMS OF SECTION 53 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT 28 OF 2002) AS AMENDED (HEREINAFTER REFERED TO AS "THE ACT"): ACWA POWER SOLARRESERVE REDSTONE SOLAR THERMAL POWER PLANT (PTY) LTD: REMAINING PORTION OF THE FARM 469, SITUATED WITHIN THE ADMINISTRTIVE DISTRICT OF HAY.

1. In terms of section 53(1) of the Act, any person who intends to use the surface of any land in any way which may be contrary to any object of this Act or which is likely to impede any such object must apply to the Minister for approval in a prescribed manner.
