




Company structure





Overview of the Waterkloof "Phaphama" iron ore project-NC

- Motjoli holds the Blackridge Prospecting Right (NC 30/5/1/2/11434
 PRR) -86 500 hectares.
- Resource estimate 10.46 Mt at 60.1% Fe, additional prospecting underway
- A mining right application to mine iron ore, zinc, copper, lead and manganese was lodged 16 May 2018 and accepted 27 August 2018.
- LOM- 8 years (Open pit)
- Production- 1 250 000





MPRDA, 2002

- The purpose of Mineral and Petroleum Resource Development Act, 2002, (Act no28 of 2002) (MPRDA) is amongst others to transform the mining and production industries in South Africa.
- In order to ensure effective transformation in this regard, the act requires the submission of Social and Labour Plan (SLP) as prerequisite for the granting of mining right.
- This SLP was compiled in accordance with Mining Charter published 2010.





Social and Labour Plan (Motjoli)

- Motjoli will meaningfully contribute towards the development of mine community in terms of impact creation and implementation of sustainable community development programmes and projects.
- Motjoli has identified priority projects as per the approved IDP of Siyancuma Local Municipality.
