You have been identified as a potential stakeholder, to be notified, in accordance with Regulation 41 of GN No. R.982 of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act No. 107 of 1998 and the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014, as amended) with respect to the above-mentioned Project.

Please take note of the following important information, for your consideration.

<u>Project Proposal:</u> The Applicant (Brandvalley Wind Farm (Pty) Ltd) wishes to upgrade the existing technology of the approved 140MW Wind Energy Facility (WEF), which same WEF has already been authorised by the Competent Authority (Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) on 23 November 2016, with the DEA reference number 14/12/16/3/3/2/900.

<u>Proposed Amendment:</u> The proposed amendment will entail the following changes:

- an increase in wind turbine rotor diameter 140m to 160m
- an increase in hub height and mast height from 120m to up to 125m
- an increase in generation capacity from 2-5.5MW
- micro-siting a single turbine within the development layout.

<u>Property Location:</u> The Project was authorised across the following land parcels: the remainder of Barendskraal 76; portion 1 of Barendskraal 76; the remainder of Brandvalley 75; portion 1 of Brandvalley 75; the remainder of Fortuin 74; portion 3 Fortuin 74; the remainder of Kabeltouw 160; the remainder of Muishond Rivier 161; portion 1 of Muishond Rivier 161; portion 1 of Fortuin 74 (Ou Mure); the Farm Rietfontein 197. The project is located within the Komsberg Renewable Energy Development Zone within the Western and Northern Cape Provinces.

Activities for which Environmental Authorisation is being sought:
