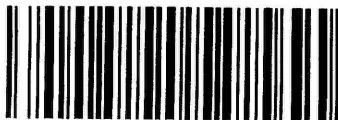

1. Decommissioning Plan

A decommissioning plan is outlined in Chapter 9 of the Environmental Management Programme (EMP), attached as Appendix K (Phase 1), Appendix L (Phase 2), Appendix M (Phase 3) and Appendix N (Phase 4) of the Draft Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report. The decommissioning plan highlights where and how the material used will be disposed of. It further outlines the activities that would need to be undertaken in order to rehabilitate the disturbed land.

2. Consultation with the Department of Agriculture

As part of the public participation component of the EIA process, a focus group meeting was held with the Department of Agriculture in Botshabelo on 31 January 2013. We still await formal comment from the Department of Agriculture.

A soil and agricultural survey of the site was undertaken as part of the EIA. It was concluded that the proposed Merapi PV facility site will be located on generally LOW potential agricultural land. In addition, the layout of proposed PV facility has been strategically planned to mitigate loss of potential agricultural land.

From an agricultural perspective, this development will not impact on the agricultural potential of the site. Areas currently used for agricultural purposes will remain available for this land use.
