This set of houses are typical mid 1970's functional. Their exteriors don't really cause much excitement except that each has a different exterior appearance that distinguishes them from each other. This may be from later changes or by design but I have not been able to research or analyse this. Asbestos roof, gutters, watertanks, fascia.

The front doors are all meranti and in place with typical stained glass decorative circles. The stoeps all have a greenish tinted masonry tile.

The vibracrete perimeter walls are from more or less the same era and each also shows individualisation.

The interiors are more significant because the original meranti pelmets, typical 70's light fittings and parquet red teak floors have not been disturbed.
