AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 28 MARCH 2013 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 75MW PHOTOVOLTAIC SOLAR FACILITY ON A PORTION OF PORTION 1 OF THE FARM HANSKOPFONTEIN 40 ROAD NEAR KIMBERLEY, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 28 March 2013, your application for amendment to the EA received by this Department on 18 May 2015 and the acknowledgement letter dated 28 May 2015 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, has decided to amend the EA dated 28 March 2013 as follows:

Amendment 1: Amendment to the project description on Page 04 of the EA:

From:

"Multiple panels will be required to form the solar PV arrays which will comprise the PV facility. The PV panels will be tilted at a fixed northern angle in order to capture the most sun."

To:

"Multiple modules will be required to form the solar PV array which will comprise the PV facility. The PV modules will either be titled at a fixed angle, or mounted on trackers tracking from east to west during the day in order to capture the most solar energy."

Furthermore, a shapefile of the approved development layout/footprint must be submitted to this Department within two (2) months from the date of this letter. The shapefile must be created using the Hartebeesthoek 94 Datum and the data should be in Decimal Degree Format using the WGS 84 Spheroid. The shapefile must include at a minimum the following extensions i.e. .shp; .shx; .dbf; .prj; and, .xml (Metadata file). If specific symbology was assigned to the file, then the .avl and/or the .lyr file must also be included. Data must be mapped at a scale of 1:10 000 (please specify if an alternative scale was used). The metadata must include a description of the base data used for digitizing. The shapefile must be submitted in a zip file using the EIA application reference number as the title.
